This is in response to a citizen request for the removal of signs prohibiting right turn on red for southbound traffic at the intersection of West State Street and North 10th Street. The signs were installed because the intersection had multiple right turn paths when the southwest-bound on-ramp to Interstate Highways 43/94 was open to traffic. However, since the southwest-bound on-ramp to Interstate Highways 43/94 is closed indefinitely, we are recommending the removal of the signs prohibiting right turn on red for southbound traffic at the intersection because it creates unnecessary delay for southbound traffic, increasing congestion and wasting fuel.

We will prepare the necessary legislation that will be heard at the next Public Safety Committee meeting, so you may support it to final passage.
