There is a possibility that your application may be denied for one or more of the following reasons: The recommendation of the committee regarding the application shall be based on evidence presented at the hearing. Per MCO 85-4-4, unless otherwise specified in the code, probative evidence concerning non-renewal, suspension or revocation may include evidence of the following: failure of the applicant to meet municipal qualifications, pending charges against or the conviction of any felony, misdemeanor, municipal offense or other offense, the circumstances of which substantially relate to the circumstances of the particular licensed or permitted activity, by the applicant or by any employee or other agent of the applicant. If the activities of the applicant involve a licensed premises, whether the premises tends to facilitate a public or private nuisance or has been the source of congregations of persons which have resulted in any of the following: disturbance of the peace; illegal drug activity; public drunkenness; drinking in public; harassment of passers-by; gambling; prostitution; sale of stolen goods; public urination; theft; assaults; battery; acts of vandalism including graffiti, excessive littering, loitering, illegal parking, loud noise at times when the licensed premise is open for business; traffic violations; curfew violations; lewd conduct; display of materials harmful to minors, pursuant to s. 106-9.6; or any other factor which reasonably relates to the public health, safety and welfare, or failure to comply with the approved plan of operation. Notice for applicants with warrants or unpaid fines:

If you wish to do so and at your own expense, you may be accompanied by an attorney of your choosing to represent you at this hearing.

You will be given an opportunity to speak on behalf of the application and to respond and challenge any charges or reasons given for the denial. No petitions can be accepted by the committee, unless the people who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify. You may present witnesses under oath and you may also confront and cross-examine opposing witnesses under oath. If you have difficulty with the English language, you should bring an interpreter with you, at your expense, so that you can answer questions and participate in your hearing.

This report is written by Police Officer Monreal, assigned to the License Investigation Unit, Days.

The Milwaukee Police Department's investigation regarding this application revealed the following:

- 1. On 02/012019 officers conducted a licensed premise check at Capitol Mini Mart, 2329 W. Capitol Dr. The officer identified the clerk as the applicant and requested to see the licenses. All licenses were up to date and the store was clean and in good order. The officer observed several knives behind the counter and asked if there was a gun. The applicant stated he had a gun on his person and showed the officer his Carrying Concealed Weapon permit. The officer advised the applicant to notify officers that he was armed in the future.
- 2. On 12/27/23 at 11:53a.m., Milwaukee Police conducted a License Premise Check at 2329 W. Capitol Dr. This was an attempt to recover video surveillance from the business for an incident that occurred at 2401 W. Capitol, in which the employee on several attempts, advised officers they could not access the system. However, the agent stated the employee does have access and they would contact them and advise them to allow officers access. On arrival officers confronted the employee about the conflicting story, however, the employee did not provide an answer. The employee then proceeded to manipulate the camera settings in an attempt to select a playback video that would not have been helpful. The officer asked if they could make an attempt, and were able to immediately video that would have been helpful in their investigation, however, due to the delay in accessing it, it was no longer available.

#### LICENSED PREMISE REPORT

This report is being written by PO Stephen COLWELL, assigned to District Five, Early Power Shift, Squad 5266.

On Wednesday, December 27th, 2023, at 11:53 AM, I conducted a Business Check at 2329 W Capitol Dr (Capitol Mini Mart), located within the City and County of Milwaukee. The purpose of this business check was to attempt to recover video footage of an incident that occurred in the area on 12/22/23.

On Friday, 12/22/23, at 2:38 PM, PO Christopher SCHLEI in Squad 5264 and I were dispatched to 2401 W Capitol Dr for the ShotSpotter complaint. (See IR 233560081) While conducting a canvass regarding the ShotSpotter, I observed exterior cameras affixed to the business located at 2329 W Capitol Dr. PO SCHLEI and I entered the business and spoke to the only employee on duty, who was later identified by his WI ID as **Keefah M NAZAR (W/M, 8/21/1997)**.

NAZAR stated he did not have access to the camera system and officers would need to return at a later time when the owner was on site. The owner was later identified as **Mohammed F NAZER (W/M, 1/1/1965)**.

On 12/25/23, at approximately 12:30 PM, PO Spencer KILBEY and I in Squad 5242 returned to the business to attempt to recover the video footage. KEEFAH again stated he did not have access to the camera system and officers would need to return. I provided KEEFAH my contact card along with the incident date and time and requested he provide my information to MOHAMMED to schedule a time to recover video.

On 12/26/23, at approximately 1:00 PM, I located a phone number for MOHAMMED and called him to schedule a time to recover video footage. MOHAMMED informed me the employee on duty could provide this access and that he would call the clerk on duty to inform him officers would be coming to the store. At 2:26 PM, 12/26/23, CSO Ronald PENEBAKER in Squad 5194 conducted follow-up at the location to recover video footage. (CAD: 233600731) CSO PENEBAKER would later inform me that when he arrived at the location, KEEFAH told him that the exterior cameras were dummy cameras and there was no video footage to be recovered.

On 12/27/23, at 11:53 AM, I conducted follow-up to speak with KEEFAH about the statements he made to me and CSO PENEBAKER regarding the cameras. When I arrived on scene, KEEFAH was behind the counter assisting a customer. I told KEEFAH I would wait until he was done assisting customers so I could speak with him. When KEEFAH opened the door to the secured cashier area I observed him to be armed with two semiautomatic pistols. One pistol grip was observed protruding from his right pants pocket and

a second pistol grip was protruding from his right hip area.

KEEFAH again stated he did not have access to the cameras and only the owner could provide this access. I asked KEEFAH about the statements he made to CSO PENEBAKER about the cameras being "dummy cameras". KEEFAH stated that not all of the exterior cameras are operational. I asked KEEFAH why MOHAMMED would give officers permission to go to the store to recover footage if it no one else was able to access it. KEEFAH did not provide an answer to this question.

One of the cameras displayed on the monitor was a camera facing south on the 3900 block of N 24th St. This camera would have captured the vehicles involved in the 12/22/23 ShotSpotter as they travelled southbound. I then requested KEEFAH at least attempt to review video footage of the incident. KEEFAH manipulated the mouse of the camera system and entered the menu for the cameras network settings, which I found to be an odd selection if he was attempting to playback video. KEEFAH stated he could not access the footage despite not being prompted to enter a DVR password. I then asked KEEFAH if I could attempt to view video. I then clicked on the desired camera, selected "playback", and was immediately able to access past video footage without being prompted to enter a password. The oldest video footage available for playback of this camera was from 12/24/23. Due to the delay in accessing video footage, any evidentiary footage has been lost and unable to be recovered.

Please make such requests no later than one business day prior to the start of the meeting. You are not required to attend the hearing, but please see the information below if you would like to provide testimony. Once the Licenses Committee makes its recommendation, this recommendation is forwarded to the full Common Council for approval at its next regularly scheduled hearing.

# Important details for those wishing to provide information for the Licenses Committee to consider when making its recommendation:

- 1. The license application is scheduled to be heard at the above time. Due to other hearings running longer than scheduled, you may have to wait some time to provide your testimony.
- 2. You must appear in person and testify as to matters that you have personally experienced or seen. (You cannot provide testimony for your neighbor, parent or anyone else; this is considered hearsay and cannot be considered by the committee.)
- 3. No letters or petitions can be accepted by the committee (unless the person who wrote the letter or the persons who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify).
- 4. Persons opposed to the license application are given the opportunity to testify first; supporters may testify after the opponents have finished.
- 5. When you are called to testify, you will be sworn in and asked to give your name, and address. (If your first and/or last names are uncommon please spell them.)

- 6. You may then provide testimony.
- a. Include only information relating to the above license application.
- b. Include only information you have personally witnessed or seen.
- c. Provide concise and relevant information detailing how this business has affected or may affect the peaceful enjoyment of your neighborhood.
- d. If by the time you have the opportunity to testify, the information you wish to share has already been provided to the committee, you may state that you agree with the previous testimony. Redundant or repetitive testimony will not assist the committee in making its recommendation.
- 7. After giving your testimony, the members of the Licenses Committee and the licensee may ask questions regarding the testimony you have given or other factors relating to the license application.
- 8. Business Competition is not a valid basis for denial or non-renewal of a license.

Please Note: If you have submitted an objection to the above application your objection cannot be considered by the committee unless you personally testify at the hearing.
