Per MCO 85-4-4, unless otherwise specified in the code, probative evidence concerning non-renewal, suspension or revocation may include evidence of the following: failure of the applicant to meet municipal qualifications, pending charges against or the conviction of any felony, misdemeanor, municipal offense or other offense, the circumstances of which substantially relate to the circumstances of the particular licensed or permitted activity, by the applicant or by any employee or other agent of the applicant. This report is written by P.O. Harold ALMAS assigned to District 6, Early Power Shift.

On Tuesday May 27, 2025, the following squads: 6243 (ALMAS, H) and 6190 (MCINNES, D) were dispatched to the address of 3334 S. 27th St (Taco Bell), which is located in the City and County of Milwaukee, Wisconsin to investigate a subject with gun complaint.

Upon arrival, I spoke to Tasheka D ROGERS (F/B 10-22-86) who is an employee of Taco Bell. ROGERS stated an unknown Black Male (Uber Eats Driver) entered into the Taco Bell looking for his delivery order. ROGERS stated that the order was being made and that he will have to wait. ROGERS stated the unidentified Black male became very upset and began to use foul language towards her stated "My fucking order should have been done over an hour ago". ROGERS stated the foul and abusive language continued towards her. ROGERS allege that the unidentified Black male removed an unknown Black firearm from his pants pocket and pointed it at her. ROGERS stated she was working with another employee who was identified as Maguel D GOODLOW (M/B 4-15-95). ROGERS stated the unidentified Black Male was advised that the Police were called. ROGERS stated the unidentified Black Male then left the Taco Bell restaurant and entered into a Brown pick-up truck and fled the location. ROGERS provided a plate number of DXY810. I conducted an E-time search of the vehicle plate and received a negative result-no vehicle match.

INTERVIEW OF GOODLOW:

GOODLOW stated he was preparing the Uber order when the unidentified Black male arrived. GOODLOW stated he observed the incident and stated the unidentified Black male was yelling obscenities at ROGERS. GOODLOW stated he intervened by telling the unidentified Black male to leave the store. GOODLOW stated the unidentified stated "Shut the fuck up talking to me". GOODLOW stated he then observed the unidentified Black male fumbling in his pockets and alleges he observed what appeared to be a Black Glock handgun and flashed it and then stated the unidentified Black male point the firearm at ROGERS.

INTERVIEW OF Brian J BURAZIN (M/W 11-29-78):

I observed BURAZIN sitting at a table inside the restaurant Southwest corner upon my entry into the restaurant. BURAZIN stated he was sitting with a friend. BURAZIN stated he only heard the incident, however, did not observe anything. I asked BURZIN where his friend went to and he stated he left when

SURVEILLANCE:

There is internal surveillance inside the restaurant. At the time of this report employees were unable to find a manager who would come to the store for officers to view camera footage and stated officers will have to come in on Wednesday May 28 to see the footage.

I spoke to LT HALL and advised him of this incident. I was advised by LT HALL to file this as a Disorderly conduct W/Armed until uniformed officers can view the video.

I was able to obtain the Uber Eats receipt that is part of this incident. The receipt is uploaded to evidence.com.

This report is written by PO Joseph ZINGSHEIM, assigned to District 6, Early Power Shift. On Saturday, 09/06/25 at 3:31 PM PO Joel BUNKELMAN and I (SQD 6523) responded to Taco Bell, 3334 S 27th St for a Shots Fired call. PO Matthew BOUZEK and PO Abdallah AL-ALAWNEH (SQD 6120), PO Nathan GRAP and PO Robert LAWRENCE (SQD 6581), PO Bradley BAKER and PO Gino HERNANDEZ (SQD 6130), and PO Luciano ROGERS (SQD 6062) also responded.

The initial call from a citizen stated a subject had fired shots in front of the location, destroyed the bus shelter, and went inside of the Taco Bell and was giving employees a hard time. A second call came in from Tammy Rogers, Manager of Taco Bell, stating the subject was inside of the location making threats to staff.

Upon arrival I observed a subject fitting the description provided exit the Taco Bell and staff advised he was the subject involved; the subject was then detained. I spoke to the 65-year-old citizen caller who stated the subject was at the bus stop when she got off of the bus. She stated the subject was rambling and she did not know what he was saying to her. She stated she entered the Taco Bell and the subject followed her and made threats to have his daughter commit physical violence against her; this caused her to fear for her safety.

I spoke to Tammy Rogers who stated the subject lit a cigarette inside of the location and began smoking. She stated they asked the subject to leave, and he began threatening to physically harm her and the staff, causing her to fear for her safety. ROGERS was cooperative throughout the investigation. The location did not have any security officers but does have video surveillance cameras. We did not request to review the cameras because it was not necessary for the investigation. The investigation revealed the

subject was not armed and the popping noises were debris in the roadway being ran over by vehicles.

The hearing before the Licenses Committee will take place on 4/28/2026 at 10:30 AM in Room 301-B, Third Floor, City Hall. This is a public hearing. Those wishing to view the proceeding are able to do so via the City Channel – Channel 25 on Spectrum Cable – or on the Internet at <http://city.milwaukee.gov/citychannel>. Those wishing to provide oral testimony via internet are asked to contact the staff assistant, Yadira Melendez at (414) 286-2775 or stasst5@milwaukee.gov for necessary information. Please make such requests no later than one business day prior to the start of the meeting. You are not required to attend the hearing, but please see the information below if you would like to provide testimony. Once the Licenses Committee makes its recommendation, this recommendation is forwarded to the full Common Council for approval at its next regularly scheduled hearing.

Important details for those wishing to provide information for the Licenses Committee to consider when making its recommendation:

1. The license application is scheduled to be heard at the above time. Due to other hearings running longer than scheduled, you may have to wait some time to provide your testimony.
2. You must appear in person and testify as to matters that you have personally experienced or seen. (You cannot provide testimony for your neighbor, parent or anyone else; this is considered hearsay and cannot be considered by the committee.)
3. No letters or petitions can be accepted by the committee (unless the person who wrote the letter or the persons who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify).
4. Persons opposed to the license application are given the opportunity to testify first; supporters may testify after the opponents have finished.
5. When you are called to testify, you will be sworn in and asked to give your name, and address. (If your first and/or last names are uncommon please spell them.)
6. You may then provide testimony.
