RE: Request to Extend Temporary Appointments – Marc Miller, Ernestine Sims and Eric Wilson Water Repair Worker 2 (Auxiliary)

Dear City Service Commissioners:

Milwaukee Water Works (MWW) respectfully requests extensions of the temporary appointments of Marc Miller, Ernestine Sims and Eric Wilson to the position of Water Repair Worker 2 (Auxiliary).

Each employee was temporarily appointed to the position on July 6, 2025, such that the 90-day appointment expired on October 11, 2025. If granted, these would be first extensions, retroactive to the original expiration date.

MWW holds position authority for six (6) auxiliary Water Repair Worker 2 (0.5 FTE) positions in its Distribution Section to increase staffing during seasonal operations, when crews perform hydrant painting, hydrant flushing and valve exercising. These operations are scheduled to continue through the end of November and then for as long as possible while the weather is still conducive to such activities.

As such, MWW requests a 90-day extension of these temporary appointments, which would result in a new expiration date of January 17, 2026.
