This report is written by Police Officer Penny Monreal, assigned to the License Investigation Unit, Days.

The Milwaukee Police Department's investigation regarding this application revealed the following:

1. On 03/23/24 at 10:00p.m., Milwaukee Police assigned to Code Red, were standing near 154 E. Juneau., when they observed security at the business allowing patrons to exit with alcoholic beverages. Officers further observed security allowing patrons to congregate in the front of the bar, causing numerous problems.
2. On 05/12/24 at 12:55a.m., Milwaukee Police were dispatched to a Battery at 158 E. Juneau Ave. Investigation revealed a patron was found in a restricted area and confronted by an employee. When the patron turned quickly, the employee was startled and began to fall backwards, grabbing at the patron, causing them both to fall down the stairs. At the bottom a physical fight ensued between the two. The business was cooperative and provided video surveillance of the incident.

On Friday, March 22, 2024, at 10pm, officer Dominique THOMPSON and I were working Code Red on N. Water St. and E. Juneau Av. and we were assigned to Squad 1450.

Around 2:20 am, THOMPSON and I were standing of the corner of N. Water St and E. Juneau St right next to Dukes.

The security guards were telling everyone to leave the bar. We observed the security guards allowed the patrons to leave the bar with their alcoholic beverages in their hands. I removed about 4 beer bottles and 2 mixed alcohol drinks. Security guards also were not ensuring the patrons left from in front of the bar which allowed the patrons to congregate in a large group causing numerous problems. The security guard stated the clicker was broken so he couldn't tell how many patrons were in the bar.

While on scene, several citizens were stating to me that the security let male patrons get into the bar with a firearm. (this complaint was not substantiated).

Be advised this is a positive Licensed Premise Report.

On Sunday, May 12th, 2024, at approximately 12:55 AM, while in full duty uniform equipped with Axon Body-Worn camera and in a marked squad car, while assigned to Code Red, my partner and I responded to a Battery complaint at Dukes on Water located at 158 East Juneau Avenue, in the City and County of Milwaukee, Wisconsin.

Upon our arrival I observed a w/m verbally identified as Tyler J POWERS (w/m 11-20-1999) seated in the back of Bell Ambulance being treated for injuries to his face. POWERS stated while at DUKES he sustained his injuries from an altercation between him and security staff at Dukes.

I spoke to Daeshontay M CARTER (b/m 01-09-2002) who stated he works at Dukes as a bouncer and at approximately 12:45 AM, on May 12th, 2024, while working at Dukes, he came in contact with a w/m in a restricted area of Dukes. CARTER stated the area is where they store most of the Bar's product and only employees are allowed in that area. CARTER stated as he was headed back upstairs to the main floor of Dukes, he noticed POWERS in the restricted area of Dukes and informed him that he wasn't allowed in that area. CARTER then stated he told POWERS to go back upstairs to the main floor. CARTER then said as he and POWERS proceeded to return to the main floor, as they both got to the top of the staircase, POWERS immediately turned around and jumped toward him, slightly startling him. CARTER stated this caused him to fall backwards down the stairs. CARTER then said as he was falling backwards, he grabbed POWERS not knowing if POWERS was attacking him which caused both POWERS and CARTER to fall down the stairs. CARTER stated when both he and POWER got to the bottom of the staircase, he believed POWERS was attacking him, so CARTER stated he defended himself against POWERS.

I spoke to licensed premise manager Timothy S SLUGA (m/w 07-05-1979) who stated while he was on duty at Dukes when this incident occurred. SLUGA stated his barback/bouncer CARTER informed him that he was involved in an altercation with a patron that wandered into a restricted part of the business while he was there getting ice. SLUGA stated he then went to view surveillance footage of the area where the incident took place and was able view what happened. SLUGA stated the footage showed CARTER and POWERS engage in a brief conversation with CARTER following behind POWERS as he went back up a flight of stairs from the restricted area. SLUGA then stated the footage showed both POWERS and CARTER immediately fall back down the stairs and get into a physical altercation and shortly ending afterwards. SLUGA stated he was then approached by POWERS who had his cellphone out recording their interaction and POWERS stating he was just assaulted by CARTER. SLUGA stated POWERS was then escorted out of DUKES without further incident.

During my investigation SLUGA along with CARTER were very cooperative in relaying information regarding this incident. Shortly after my investigation was complete SLUGA provided a copy of surveillance footage from this incident to AXON.

Once the Licenses Committee makes its recommendation, this recommendation is forwarded to the full Common Council for approval at its next regularly scheduled hearing.

Important details for those wishing to provide information for the Licenses Committee to consider when making its recommendation:

1. The license application is scheduled to be heard at the above time. Due to other hearings running longer than scheduled, you may have to wait some time to provide your testimony.
2. You must appear in person and testify as to matters that you have personally experienced or seen. (You cannot provide testimony for your neighbor, parent or anyone else; this is considered hearsay and cannot be considered by the committee.)
3. No letters or petitions can be accepted by the committee (unless the person who wrote the letter or the persons who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify).
4. Persons opposed to the license application are given the opportunity to testify first; supporters may testify after the opponents have finished.
5. When you are called to testify, you will be sworn in and asked to give your name, and address. (If your first and/or last names are uncommon please spell them.)
6. You may then provide testimony.
 - a. Include only information relating to the above license application.
 - b. Include only information you have personally witnessed or seen.
 - c. Provide concise and relevant information detailing how this business has affected or may affect the peaceful enjoyment of your neighborhood.
 - d. If by the time you have the opportunity to testify, the information you wish to share has already been provided to the committee, you may state that you agree with the previous testimony. Redundant or repetitive testimony will not assist the committee in making its recommendation.
7. After giving your testimony, the members of the Licenses Committee and the licensee may ask questions regarding the testimony you have given or other factors relating to the license application.
8. Business Competition is not a valid basis for denial or non-renewal of a license.
Please Note: If you have submitted an objection to the above application your objection cannot be considered by the committee unless you personally testify at the hearing.


