
REASON FOR REQUEST:

Christopher Zimmerman, who was a Detective with the City of Milwaukee Police Department, was in the scope of his employment and operating a City of Milwaukee Police vehicle that was traveling northbound on North 25th Street. As the City vehicle entered the intersection of North 25th Street and West Clybourn Street, the uninsured motorist, who was proceeding eastbound on West Clybourn Street, failed to yield the right away by disregarding the red traffic signal, causing the accident. As a result of the conduct of the uninsured motorist(s), there is liability on the City of Milwaukee pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 62.67 and the City of Milwaukee's Uninsured Motorist Self-Insurance Plan.

Detective Zimmerman, who retired on September 7, 2017, sustained injuries to his neck, back, ribs, and knees. The claimed medical expenses and lost wages total \$9,505.84.
