Dear Ms. Polanco:

This office has had the opportunity to review whether the applicant has any outstanding debts with the Milwaukee Municipal Court. I am pleased to report that Ms. Parish has no such outstanding debts.

This application was submitted by Patrick Parish on behalf of his mother, Allie Parish. Based on the application submitted and conversations with Mr. Parish and his brother, Jerome Hill, Ms. Parish is currently the ward of a guardianship under Milwaukee County Case No. 2016GN000532. The applicant is not Ms. Parish's guardian. MCO 304-50-1 permits "The former owner of record, or any person having an interest of record with the consent of the former owner of record..." to submit a request to have the in rem judgment vacated. MCO 304-50-2 provides that the "written request shall be consented to and signed by the former owner of record if the requester is not the former owner, unless the former owner is deceased or cannot be located following diligent search and inquiry." The "common council may, in its discretion, waive the requirement that the former owner of record consent to the applicant's request if the common council finds that it is in the city's best interest to do so." MCO 304-50-2.

Based on the above information and the information it discerns at the meeting, the Committee must decide if the application submitted by Mr. Parish is sufficient to vacate the in rem judgment.
