- AB-802/SB-765**                      **Relating to: criteria for the court to consider when determining whether to use videoconferencing at a proceeding.**
- AB-803/SB-766**                      **Relating to: using testimony taken by deposition in a criminal trial if witness is at risk of being intimidated.**
- AB-804/SB-767**                      **Relating to: intimidating a victim of domestic abuse and providing a penalty.**
- AB-805/SB-752**                      **Relating to: recommendation to revoke parole, probation, and extended supervision if a person is charged with a crime.**
- AB-806/SB-753**                      **Relating to: acts for which a juvenile may be placed in correctional placement or the Serious Juvenile Offender Program.**
- AB-807/SB-749**                      **Relating to: mandatory minimum sentence for three or more convictions for retail theft and providing a penalty.**
- AB-808/SB-745**                      **Relating to: prosecuting a violent felon for the crime of illegal possession of a firearm.**
- AB-809/SB-754**                      **Relating to: earned release from parole or extended supervision and discharge from probation.**

**AB-817** Relating to: bail for a criminal defendant who is charged with bail jumping.

**AB-770/SB-703** Relating to: interest rates on payday loans and loans by licensed lenders.

**LRB-4317** Relating to: making changes related to mixed-use tax incremental financing districts, increasing the amount of time a city or village may extend the life of a tax incremental district to improve its affordable and workforce housing, allowing a reduction in the amount of certain impact fees, and authorizing local units of government to implement workforce housing initiatives.

**LRB-5249** Relating to: authorizing a local government to require advance payment from a presidential or vice-presidential campaign for certain expected public event costs.

**AB-834/SB-741** Relating to: public notice of noncandidacy for incumbent local elected officials.

**AB-440/SB-479** Relating to: prohibiting discrimination based on hairstyle.

**AB-771/SB-726** Relating to: leasing tax exempt property of a church or religious organization to an educational association.
