



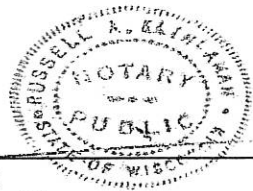

Notice is hereby given that an ordinance that was introduced at the March 27, 2018 meeting of the Milwaukee Common Council, the essence of which is as follows:

A substitute ordinance relating to the change in zoning from Multi-Family Residential, RM1, to Industrial-Light, IL1, for the northern portion of the property located at 6000 South 6th Street, on the east side of South 6th Street, north of West College Avenue, in the 13th Aldermanic District.

Resolved, That the Mayor and Common Council of the City of Milwaukee, do ordain as follows:

Part 1. There is added to the Milwaukee Code of Ordinances a new section to read as follows:

The zoning map is amended to change the zoning for a portion of 6000 South 6th Street, Tax Key No. 687-0751-000, Lot 1 of proposed CSM DCD No. 3199, from Multi-Family Residential (RM1) to Industrial-Light (IL1).

PLEASE NOTE: a) Members of the Common Council, and members of its Standing Committees who are not members of this Committee, may attend this meeting to participate or to gather information. Therefore, notice is given that this meeting may constitute a meeting of the Common Council or any of its Standing Committees, and must be noticed as such, although they will not take any formal action at this meeting.

b) If you have difficulty with the English language, you may bring an interpreter with you, at your own expense, so that you can answer questions and participate in the hearing.

c) Upon reasonable notice, efforts will be made to accommodate the needs of disabled individuals through sign language, interpreters or other auxiliary aids.
