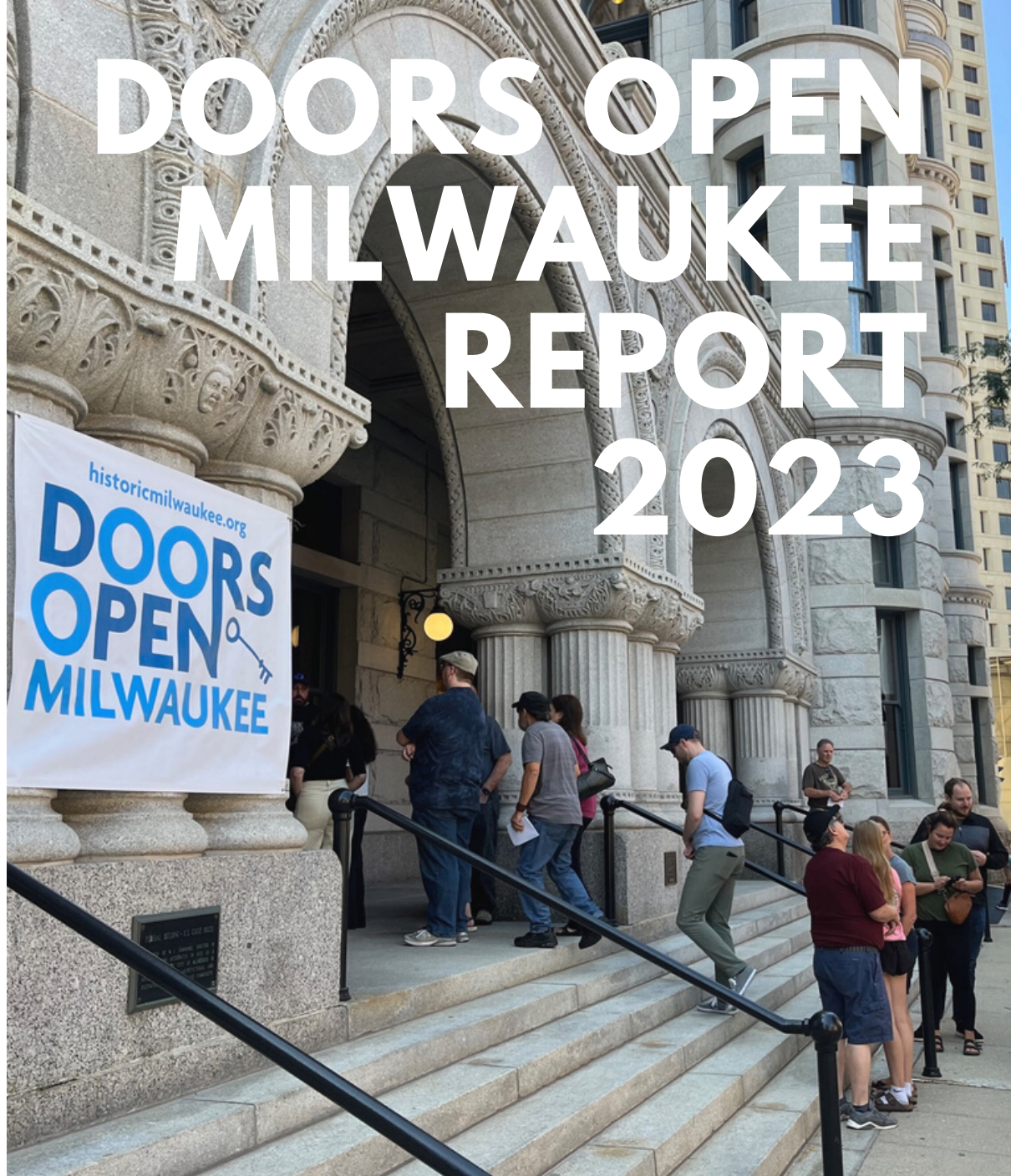




Historic Milwaukee **DOORS OPEN** MILWAUKEE **CELEBRATING 13 YEARS**

New Programs

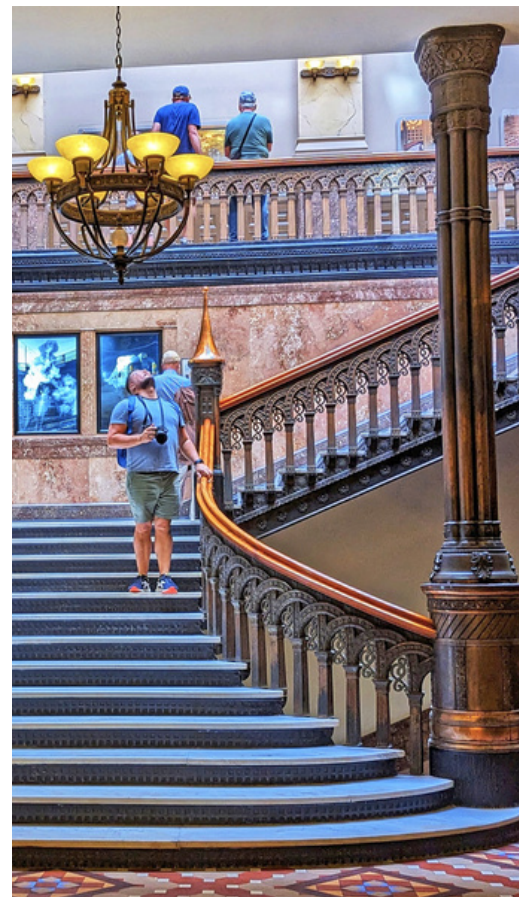

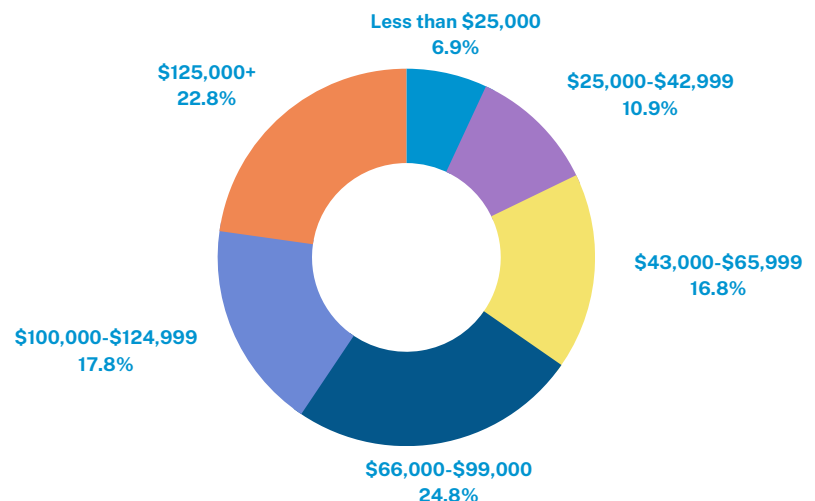
Visitor Geography
