Genetic tests were administered, pursuant to an administrative order under § 49.225, Wis. Stats. The results of the tests, copies of which are attached, show that the statistical probability that RICKEY L ADAMS is the father is 99.99%.

NOTICE TO PARTIES

- 1. You are a party to a petition for paternity. A judgment of paternity legally designates the child in the case to be a child of the man found to be the father. It creates a legally recognized parent-child relationship between the man and the child. It creates the right of inheritance for the child, and obligates the man to support the child until the child reaches the age of 18, or the age of 19 if the child is enrolled full-time in high school or its equivalent. The failure by either parent to pay court-ordered support is punishable by imprisonment as a contempt of court or as a criminal violation.
- 2. A party to a paternity case has the right to be represented by an attorney. If you are unable to afford an attorney and you are a man who is named as the possible father of a child in a paternity case, the court will appoint an attorney for you only if the results of one or more genetic tests show that you are not excluded as the father and that the statistical probability of your being the father is less than 99.0 percent. In order to determine whether you are entitled to have an attorney appointed for you, you may call the local State Public Defender office.
- 3. The petitioner in this case has the burden of proving by a clear and satisfactory preponderance of the evidence whether the man named as the possible father is the father. However, if genetic tests show that the man named is not excluded as the father, and show that the statistical probability that the man is the father is 99.0 percent or higher, that man is rebuttably presumed to be the father.
- 4. You may request genetic tests which will indicate the probability that the man named as the possible father is or is not the father of the child. The court will order genetic tests on a request by you, the state or any other party. Any person who refuses to take court-ordered genetic tests may be punished for contempt of court.
- 5. The following defenses are available in a paternity case:
 - (a) The man named as a possible father of the child may claim that he was sterile or impotent at the time of conception.
 - (b) The mother may claim that she, or the man named as a possible father may claim that he, did not have sexual intercourse with the other party during the conceptive period (generally the period 8 to 10 months before the birth of the child).
 - (c) The mother or the man named as a possible father may claim that another man had sexual intercourse with the mother during the conceptive period.
- 6. You have the right to request a jury trial on the issue of whether the named man is the father.
- 7. If you fail to appear at any stage of the proceeding, including a scheduled court-ordered genetic test, the court may enter a default judgment finding the man named to be the father as the father.
- 8. You must keep the clerk of court and child support agency informed of your current address at all times.

WISCONSIN DEPARTMENT OF CHILDREN AND FAMILIES PERCENTAGE OF INCOME STANDARD -- CHILD SUPPORT GUIDELINES

AUTHORITY AND PURPOSE

Wis. Stats. Sec. 49.22(9) requires the Department to adopt and publish a standard, based upon a percentage of the gross income and assets of either or both parents, to be used by courts in determining child support obligations. Chapter DCF 150 of the Wisconsin Administrative Code establishes Wisconsin's percentage of income standard for child support. It is based upon the principle that the child's standard of living should, to the degree possible, be the same as if the child's parents were living together.

Chapter DCF 150 defines the income upon which the support obligation is based, and sets the percentages of income for computing the support obligation based upon a number of children. It also explains optional procedures for adjusting the obligation when the parents share placement, when the payer has an obligation to support another family, or when the payer has particularly high or low income.

APPLICABILITY

The percentage standard applies to any temporary and final order for child support, including child support stipulations agreed to by both parents and modifications of existing child support orders. When used to calculate family support, the amount determined under the standard should be increased by the amount necessary to provide a net family support payment, after state and federal income taxes are paid, of at least the amount of a child support payment under the standard.

DEFINITION OF INCOME AND ASSETS

Chapter DCF 150 defines gross income as income from any source, whether or not it is reported or taxed under federal law. The income can be in the form of money, property, or services. Public assistance or child support received from previous marriages or business expenses which the court determines are reasonably necessary for the production of income or operation of a business are subtracted, and wages paid to dependent household member are added to determine "gross income available for child support."

The court may also determine that income may be "imputed" (assumed at a given level) based on earning capacity and/or assets, and that imputed income is added to the gross income for the calculation of the support obligation.

THE PERCENTAGE STANDARD

The percentages are:

17% for one child 25% for two children 29% for three children 31% for four children 34% for five or more children

Wisconsin Statutes require temporary and final support orders to be expressed as fixed sum in most situations.

Wis. Stats. § 767.80 DETERMINATION OF PATERNITY or § 767.215 PETITION AND RESPONSE

Wis. Stats. §§ 767.80(7) and 767.215(1)(b) The clerk of court shall provide without charge, to each person bringing an action under this section, except to the state under Wis. Stats. § 767.80(1)(g) or (6m), a document setting forth the percentage standard established by the department under Wis. Stats. § 49.22(9) and listing the factors which a court may consider under Wis. Stats. § 767.511(1m).

STATUTORY FACTORS COURTS MAY CONSIDER IN DETERMINING CHILD SUPPORT AWARDS - PATERNITY OR DIVORCE

Wis. Stats. § 767.511(1m) Upon request by a party, the court may modify the amount of child support payments determined under Wis. Stats. § 767.511(1j) if, after considering the following factors, the court finds by the greater weight of the credible evidence that use of the percentage standard is unfair to the child or to any of the parties:

- (a) The financial resources of the child.
- (b) The financial resources of both parents.
- (bj) Maintenance received by either party.
- (bp) The needs of each party in order to support himself or herself at a level equal to or greater than that established under 42 USC 9902 (2).
- (bz) The needs of any person, other than the child, whom either party is legally obligated to support.
- (c) If the parties were married, the standard of living the child would have enjoyed had the marriage not ended in annulment, divorce or legal separation.
- (d) The desirability that the custodian remain in the home as a full-time parent.
- (e) The cost of day care if the custodian works outside the home, or the value of custodial services performed by the custodian if the custodian remains in the home.
- (ej) The award of substantial periods of physical placement to both parents.
- (em) Extraordinary travel expenses incurred in exercising the right to periods of physical placement under Wis. Stats. § 767.41.
- (f) The physical, mental and emotional health needs of the child, including any costs for health insurance as provided for under Wis. Stats. § 767.513.
- (g) The child's educational needs.
- (h) The tax consequences to each party.
- (hm) The best interests of the child.
- (hs) The earning capacity of each parent, based on each parent's education, training and work experience and the availability of work in or near the parent's community.
- (i) Any other factors which the court in each case determines are relevant.

INITIAL INVESTIGATION

This report is submitted by P.O. Alexander DEY, assigned to District 7, Early Shift, Squad 7240.

On Friday, March 19th, 2021, my partner P.O. Monica SOSA and I were dispatched to a Subject with Gun complaint at the address of 8758 W Appleton Ave, located in the City and County of Milwaukee, WI.

On the wall to the call, I observed via the CAD that the description listed the incident occurred at a "Car Dealership". I observed that 87858 W Appleton Ave was a apartment complex and that to the West of it, there was a car dealership located at 8822 W Appleton Ave. I identified the car dealership as "Adams and Claybrooks Investments LLC Auto Sales". Approaching the business, an employee stated to my partner and I that no one had called the police.

I observed that the incident scene building appeared to be a "Tire Shop" on the Northwest corner of the block. It is enclosed by a fence. At the investigation time there was a large open garage door, where I observed mechanic work being done.

As my partner and I were returning to our squad vehicle, the caller/victim identified as Kayla JONES (f/b 02-11-97) flagged us down. JONES approached from the West on the sidewalk. JONES stated that on Friday, March 19th, 2021, at approximately 4:20 PM, she had walked from the address of 8758 W Appleton Ave and was traveling towards Family Dollar located at 9014 W Appleton Ave. JONES stated that she walked past the tire shop located at 8822 W Appleton Ave when suspect described as B/F 27-28 yo, approximately 5'07" 250lbs, long braided hair, wearing a black hoodie with red leggings and a black fannypack, approached her from inside the business parking lot. JONES stated that the suspect confronted her about a male employee inside the business, who she knew by the first name as "Davonte" (wearing a Starbucks hoodie". JONES stated that the female was upset due to her having contact with "Davonte".

JONES stated that approximately two weeks ago, that the suspect had came to the residence of 8758 W Appleton Ave to talk to her about her relationship with Davonte. JONES stated that the female demanded that she end contact with him and that she had complied with her request. JONES stated that due to complying with the suspects prior request, she was surprised that she had an issue on the incident date still. JONES stated that that the female threatened her, stating "Hey you remember when I said I would fuck you up" and other profanity directed towards her. JONES stated that the female grabbed a black firearm from her fanny pack, pointed it at her, and cocked it back. JONES stated that she called Davonte over to grab the gun from the suspect. JONES stated that she walked off from the incident, walking West where she flagged down an unidentified (not on scene) citizen to use their phone to call police. JONES did not state whether or not the incident caused her to fear for her safety. JONES stated that she notified law enforcement regarding because it was the proper thing to do.

JONES stated that she had observed the suspect leave in a "black SUV", with no tinted windows, and possible WI registration plates. JONES stated that she had observed children in the vehicle. As I was interviewing JONES, she made mention of a vehicle that passed us traveling Westbound on W Appleton Ave and stated that the suspect vehicle was similar. JONES stated that the suspect vehicle was an older

model of the vehicle. I identified the vehicle as a black Volkswagen vehicle, possibly a Tiguan.

JONES described the firearm as a black and silver 9mm handgun. I asked JONES how she knew it was a 9mm, JONES stated that it is because she is familiar with firearms.

JONES stated that she had only seen the B/F suspect once before, in the mentioned time when she came over to her residence to demand that she stop talking with Davonte. JONES stated that she has only known Davonte for less than two months and did not know his last name or any other information regarding him. JONES did point out an individual at the shop who she stated was Davonte. I attempted to interview this individual. He was a B/M, dark complexion, approximately 5'07, thin build, in his 20's or 30's. I observed he was wearing a black hooded sweatshirt with a Starbucks logo. I observed that he appeared to be an employee at the tire shop and currently doing shop work. I asked Davonte if he knew anything about the situation. Davonte was reluctant to provide any information and only stated that there was an "argument", but did not specific who it was between or any specifics. I asked Davonte about the female suspect. He referenced her as his "Baby momma", but stated that he did not have any children in common with her. Davonte only identified her as "T Bubbles". I asked Davonte to further identify her and he stated that he was not comfortable with the situation. Davonte stated that he did not know her government name.

Davonte would not provide his information either. At some point during the interview, a B/M, dark complexion, approximately in his late 20's, 30's, approximately 5'8, medium build, long dreads approached me. The subject stated to me that no one at the shop observed a gun. The subject stated that I had no right to conduct an investigation on the business premise. I informed the subject that part of the crime occurred on the premise. The subject at some point requested a supervisor. Squad 7217 SGT PUGLEY responded and spoke with him regarding. The subject refused to provide any statement regarding the incident or identification regarding himself.

I observed a B/M, approximately 40 to 55 years of age, whom the workers stated was the management for the business on scene. The subject did not identify himself and stated that he was not the owner, but the manager. The subject allowed me to view the video surveillance on scene. I observed from the computer that their was a video surveillance program that had a live view which would of captured the event. I was unable to view any recording playback. I observed that it appeared the video surveillance system only showed a "live view" and did not record any data.

I observed that the employee subjects at the business were reluctant to provide any statement or identification regarding the incident. I left a community contact with the business on the main desk.

I observed that the business was on the Northwest corner of the block. I observed that due to the business building where the incident was located, the only possible witnesses would be on the business premise itself.

JONES was issued a PV-17.

Through the Wisconsin DOT website I identified that the business "Buyer License Report" displayed the business name as "Adams and Claybrooks Investments LLC". It provided the buyer name of "Rickey Adams" with dealer number of "MV 5649". NFI
