Subject: Common Council Resolution File Number 100457

Dear Honorable Members:

Returned herewith is Common Council Resolution File Number 100457, being a resolution to grant a special privilege to Bartels Limited Partnership for a covered walk and two decorative buoys in the public right-of-way for the premises at 108 West Wells Street.

Bartels Limited Partnership is requesting permission to construct and maintain a covered walk projecting 11 feet into the north, variable width sidewalk area of West Wells Street. Said 9-foot 5-inch wide covered walk is centered approximately 120 feet east of the eastline of North Plankinton Avenue and is supported by two metal legs located near the street. A site visit revealed the presence of two decorative buoys one located adjacent to each of the support legs of the covered walk.

We are not aware that the presence of said items will have an adverse effect on the general use of the public right-of-way. We have, therefore, prepared the attached special privilege resolution, which, if adopted, will allow said items to occupy the public right-of-way.
