COMPUTATION METHOD OF "CITY SHARE"

The CITY will pay, monthly, 100% of the lowest single or lowest family HMO premium cost to the City. For 2006, this contribution ("City Share") will be no more than \$385.75 (Single) or \$1,053.55 (Family) toward the cost of Health Plan of your choice. Any excess premium over these amounts ("Employee Share") will be deducted as a payroll deduction from the second paycheck of each month. Tier 1 is the BC/BS Open access for SE Wisconsin; BC/BS Tier 2 is the National Blue Cross network.
