Dear Aldermen Davis and Puente:

This is in response to a request we received from Milwaukee County to legislate the above-captioned traffic control restriction. In conjunction with the upcoming repaving of West Mill Road between North 84th Street and North 91st Street, Milwaukee County would like to install school speed limit 20 mile per hour when children are present signs to supplement the existing pentagon school signs they currently have installed on West Mill Road. Therefore, in the interest of public safety we recommend the installation of the above-captioned traffic control. Lastly, it should be known that West Mill Road from the east City limit to North 118th Street is under the jurisdiction of Milwaukee County. The signs for this restriction will be installed and maintained by Milwaukee County.

We will prepare the necessary legislation that will be heard at the next Public Safety Committee meeting, so that you may support it to final passage.
