The Milwaukee Police Department's investigation regarding this application revealed the following:

1. On 06/01/2011 the applicant was charged in Milwaukee County with Possession of THC (Misdemeanor).

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3. On 02/05/21 at 2:20am, Milwaukee Police were dispatched to 3853 N. Richards Street for a tavern violation. Investigation revealed that the applicant was remodeling his establishment for when he receives his license and no violations were observed.  
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4. On 08/03/24 at 1:47a.m., Milwaukee Police were dispatched to a Shooting that occurred at 3853 N. Richards St. Investigation revealed there were a total of 5 victims, who were transported to a hospital for their injuries. Officers were advised this was due to an altercation between patrons of this premise and a nearby bar. At the time the report was written the investigation was still on-going and detectives were recovering video surveillance. All employees were cooperative with the investigation.

5. On 01/04/25 at 11:12a.m., Milwaukee Police were dispatched to an Entry at 3853 N. Richards St. Investigation revealed the business was the victim of a Burglary. The business was cooperative with the investigation and allowed officers to view video surveillance of the incident.

6. On 01/04/25, a Detective authored a report regarding the discrepancies that were previously reported on the License Premise Report for Item #4. The first discrepancy is related to a victim stating they were inside the bar when they were shot. The detective reviewed a supplemental report in which the victim stated they were laying on the ground outside when they were shot. The second discrepancy is related to a victim being security for the bar. In reviewing the victim's statement, they stated they were from out of town, here for a family reunion, not security for the bar. The video revealed the shooting incident occurred outside of this premise and the neighboring bar was not involved in the incident either.

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7. On 11/20/25, Milwaukee Police conducted a License Premise Check. At approximately 2:00a.m., the officers observed patrons still entering the business and music along with disco lights illuminating. The officers interviewed the manager who stated the hours are Tues/Thurs 5p-2:30A, and Weds-Sat 9p-2:30A. The officer issued a Citation for Allow Patrons After Hours. On 03/30/26, the Agent was convicted and fined \$225.00. Case # 25034892

8. On 01/28/26 at 1:38a.m., Milwaukee Police were dispatched to a Shots Fired. A citizen called stating there had been a shooting at the bar earlier. The officer's conducted follow up and recovered a casing, as well as blood on the ground with a soapy substance. The officer interviewed the manager who stated they heard people fighting outside, a gunshot, and observed a subject laying on the ground, being carried away by other subjects. The manager stated they poured soapy water on the blood in an attempt to clean it away. The manager stated they didn't have access to video surveillance and provided the owner's information. No victim appeared at a hospital during the investigation and no shot spotters were detected near the location.

9. On 01/28/26 at 9:13p.m., Milwaukee Police conducted a License Premise Check. The manager stated the Agent would not return until the following week. Regarding Item #8, the manager stated they did not know what happened, but saw someone outside with blood coming from their face. The officer noted the licenses were not posted, to which the manager stated they ordered frames to be able to hang them.
  
10. On 03/14/26 at 12:18a.m., Milwaukee Police were dispatched to a Subject with Weapon. The caller stated subjects in two different vehicles made threats to shoot up the business. On arrival the officer checked the area and did not find anything suspicious in the area. The officer was unable to make contact with the caller.

Interview of Princess A HOGANS (Manager):

HOGANS stated they are open 5 days a week (Tuesday/Wednesday/Thursday/Friday/Saturday) Tuesday/Thursday 5 PM- 2:30 AM and Wednesday/Friday/Saturday 9:00 PM- 2:30 AM. HOGANS stated they have 8 or 9 employees. HOGANS stated the security cameras work and only the owner has access to view them. HOGANS stated the owner is normally easy to get ahold of. HOGANS stated they do have security at the business. HOGANS stated during the week it is normally 2 people and on the weekend it is 3 people for security.

We left the citation with HOGANS.

This report is being written by Police Officer Dana BROWN, Squad #5340, Assigned to District 5 Late Shift.

On Wednesday, January 28th, 2026, at approximately 138am Police Officer Kaleb HOLSTER and I were dispatched to a Shots Fired complaint at 3853 N Richards St., located in the City and County of Milwaukee.

An anonymous caller called into dispatch on Wednesday, January 28th, 2026, at approximately 1:37am and stated that her daughter was at the bar approximately 30 min prior to her calling. She stated that her daughter informed her there was a shooting at the bar and she scraped her knee fleeing the scene. The caller did not provide a contact number where she could be contacted.

Upon our arrival we were met by the manager of the D&D bar located at 3853 N Richards St. The manager verbally identified herself as Princess A. HOGANS (B/F 10-28-1993). HOGANS stated approximately 40 min prior to our arrival she closed the bar down because she heard people fighting outside of the bar and 1 gun shot. There was blood spots outside directly in front of the bar near the bar entrance. There was a soapy substance that appeared to have been poured over the blood stains on the ground. There was one 9mm casing located outside of the bar near the western side of the entrance.

HOGANS stated that she did not see the person who fired the weapon, however; she was a b/m man outside wearing dark blue laying on the ground in front of the bar. HOGANS stated that unidentified male was unconscious and that she saw people picking him up and carrying him away.

HOGANS did not specify if he was carried into a vehicle or not. HOGANS stated she did not see where they carried the victim to. HOGANS stated that she poured soapy water over the blood after the victim left in order to wash away the blood. HOGANS did not explain why she wanted to clean the blood away.

HOGANS stated that she does not have access to the cameras. HOGAN provided us with the owner of the bar's #414-788-7249. The owner was later identified as Davis S. DOUGLAS. (B/M).

Currently no victims have been admitted to any hospitals with reports of a gun shot womb. There were no shot spotters detected near the incident location at the time of the reported gun fire.

A canvass was conducted and a camera was located directly east of the location at Walmart's docking bay area.

3. No letters or petitions can be accepted by the committee (unless the person who wrote the letter or the persons who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify).
4. Persons opposed to the license application are given the opportunity to testify first; supporters may testify after the opponents have finished.
5. When you are called to testify, you will be sworn in and asked to give your name, and address. (If your first and/or last names are uncommon please spell them.)
6. You may then provide testimony.
  - a. Include only information relating to the above license application.
  - b. Include only information you have personally witnessed or seen.
  - c. Provide concise and relevant information detailing how this business has affected or may affect the peaceful enjoyment of your neighborhood.
  - d. If by the time you have the opportunity to testify, the information you wish to share has already been provided to the committee, you may state that you agree with the previous testimony. Redundant or repetitive testimony will not assist the committee in making its recommendation.
7. After giving your testimony, the members of the Licenses Committee and the licensee may ask questions regarding the testimony you have given or other factors relating to the license application.
8. Business Competition is not a valid basis for denial or non-renewal of a license.
