The 6 reproduction replacement doors for St Stanislaus located at 524 W Mitchell Street in Milwaukee WI designs were taken from the earliest known photo of the doors that show any details.

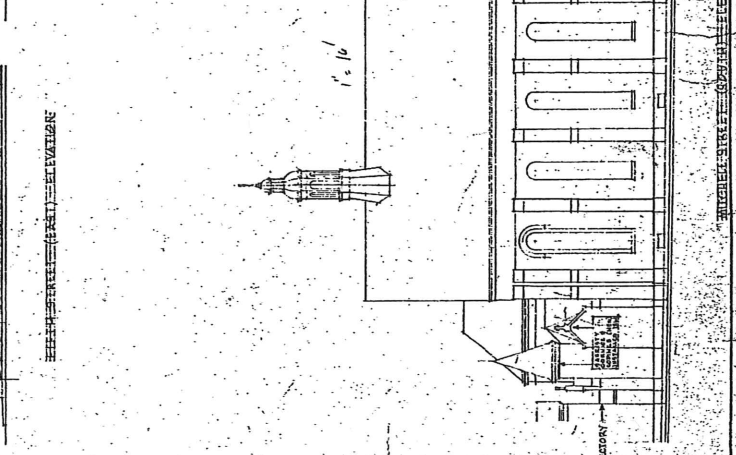
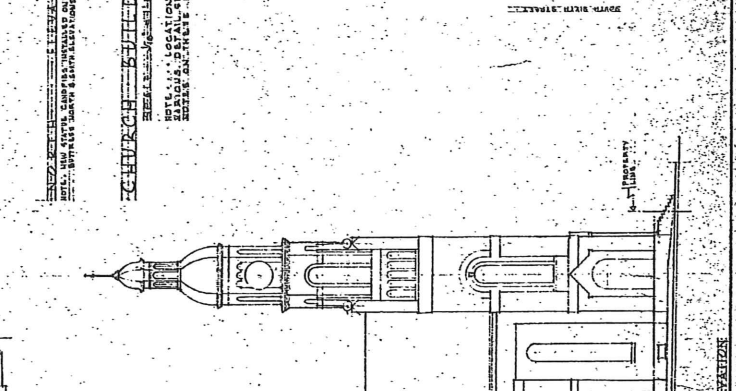
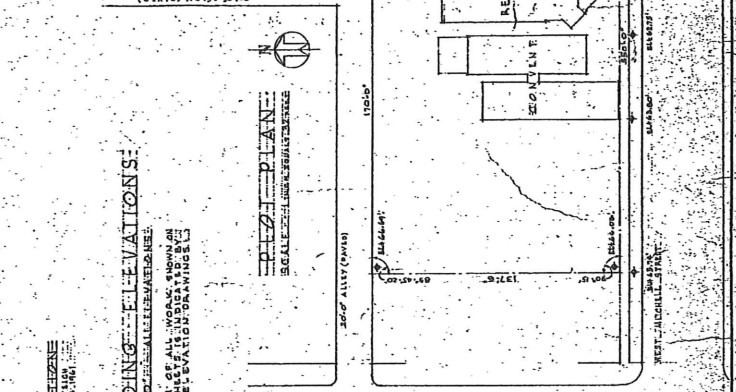
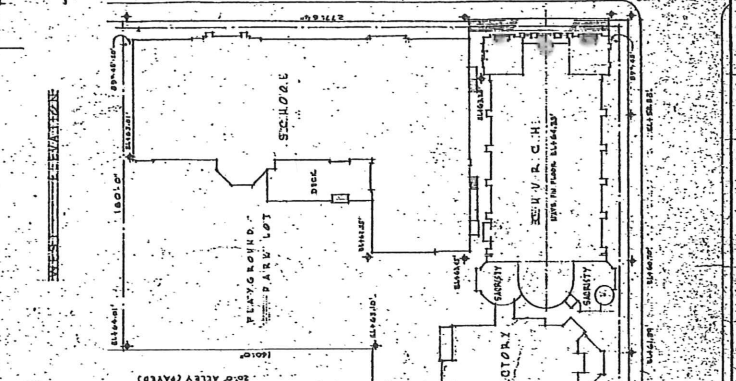
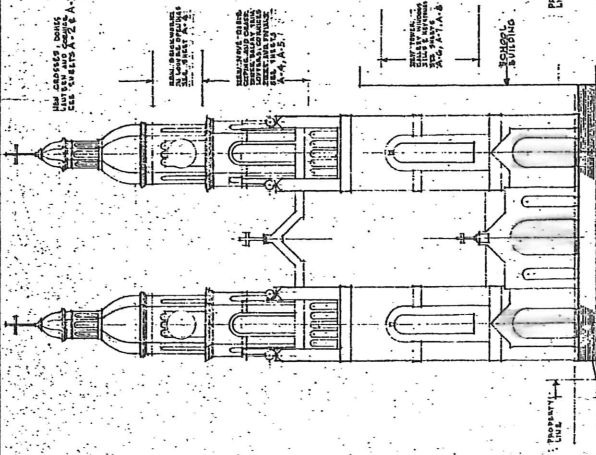
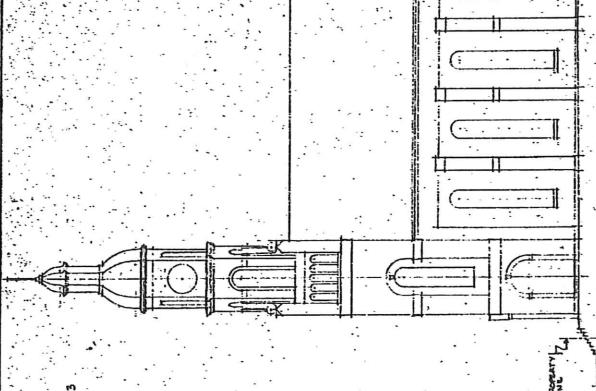
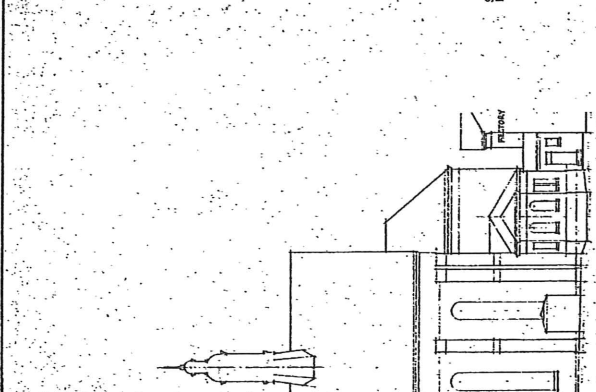
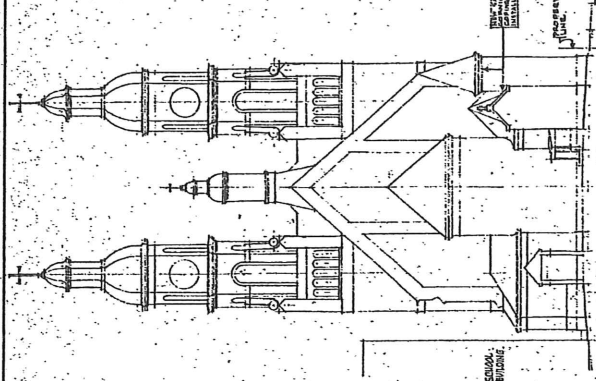
The 2 center doors are approximately 2 ½" x 40" x 120" and the flanking doors to the north and south are approximately 2 ½" x 36" x 120". The new doors will be constructed using modern construction details including engineered (LVL) cores for the stiles and rails and dowel joinery.

The faces and edges of the doors will be laminated with solid plainsawn White Oak. The bolection mouldings will miter around the raised panels on both sides of the door

The doors will retain their existing outswing operations but will be machined with modern egress hardware on the interior located at approximately 39" AFF.

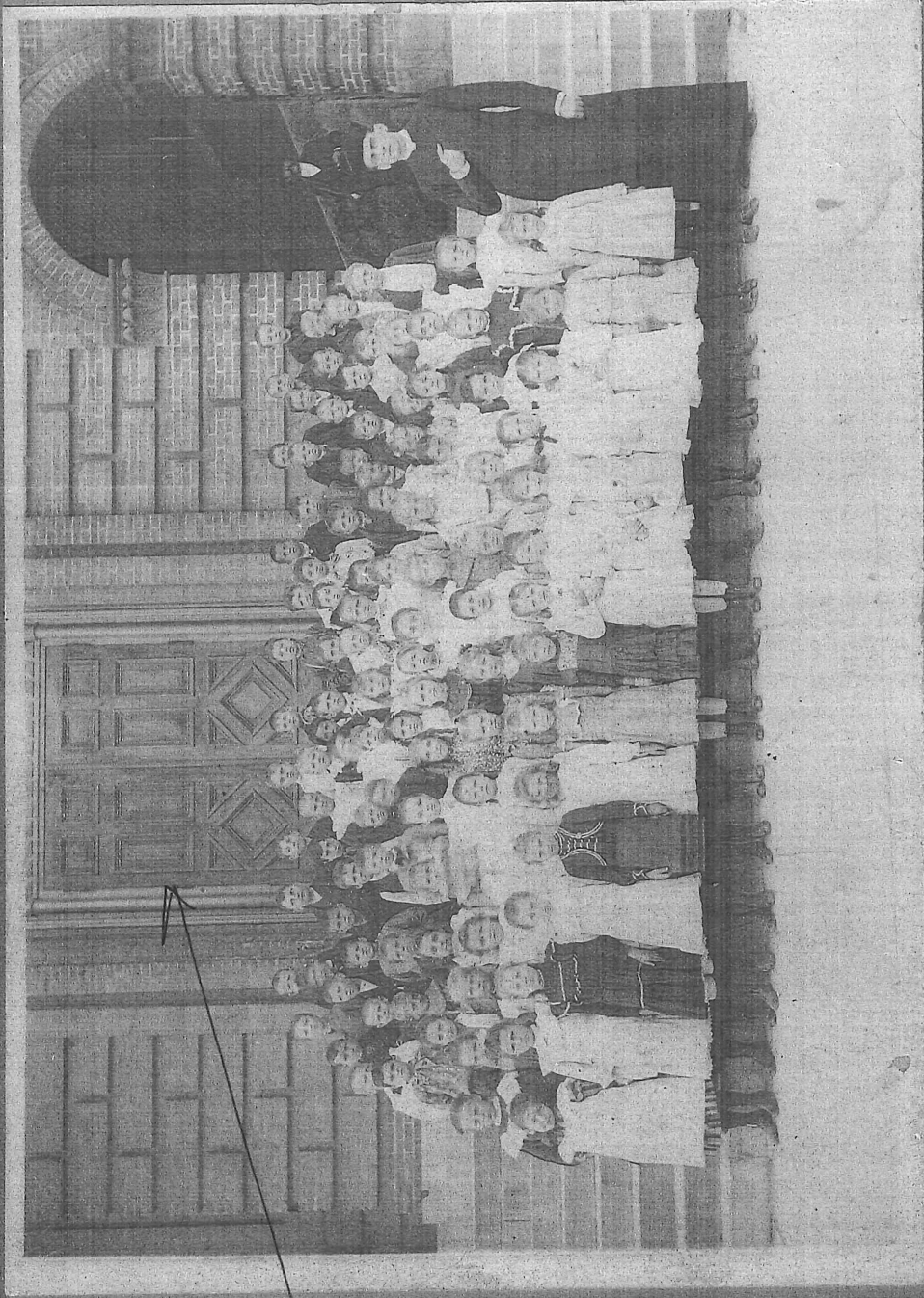
