There is a possibility that your application may be denied for one or more of the following reasons: The recommendation of the committee regarding the application shall be based on evidence presented at the hearing. Per MCO 85-4-4, unless otherwise specified in the code, probative evidence concerning non-renewal, suspension or revocation may include evidence of the following: failure of the applicant to meet municipal qualifications, pending charges against or the conviction of any felony, misdemeanor, municipal offense or other offense, the circumstances of which substantially relate to the circumstances of the particular licensed or permitted activity, by the applicant or by any employee or other agent of the applicant. If the activities of the applicant involve a licensed premises, whether the premises tends to facilitate a public or private nuisance or has been the source of congregations of persons which have resulted in any of the following: disturbance of the peace; illegal drug activity; public drunkenness; drinking in public; harassment of passers-by; gambling; prostitution; sale of stolen goods; public urination; theft; assaults; battery; acts of vandalism including graffiti, excessive littering, loitering, illegal parking, loud noise at times when the licensed premise is open for business; traffic violations; curfew violations; lewd conduct; display of materials harmful to minors, pursuant to s. 106-9.6; or any other factor which reasonably relates to the public health, safety and welfare, or failure to comply with the approved plan of operation. It is the intention of the Common Council to suspend or non-renew the licenses if objectors provide testimony related to the factors enumerated in MCO 85-4-4 that the Common Council finds to be true by a preponderance of the evidence and/or police reports are found to be true by a preponderance of the evidence. The police reports and other attached documents relating to objections to the license are a part of this notice and expressly incorporated in this notice. The licensee should be prepared to address these matters at the hearing.

Notice for applicants with warrants or unpaid fines:

Proof of warrant satisfaction or payment of fines must be submitted at the hearing on the above date and time. Failure to comply with this requirement may result in a delay of the granting/denial of your application.

Failure to appear at this meeting may result in the denial of your license. Individual applicants must appear only in person or by an attorney. Corporate or Limited Liability applicants must appear only by the agent designated on the application or by an attorney. Partnership applicants must appear by a partner listed on the application or by an attorney. If you wish to do so and at your own expense, you may be accompanied by an attorney of your choosing to represent you at this hearing.

You will be given an opportunity to speak on behalf of the application and to respond and challenge any charges or reasons given for the denial. No petitions can be accepted by the committee, unless the people who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify. You may present witnesses under oath and you may also confront and cross-examine opposing witnesses under oath. If you have difficulty with the English language, you should bring an interpreter with you, at your expense, so that you can answer questions and participate in your hearing.

You may examine the application file at this office during regular business hours prior to the hearing date. Inquiries regarding this matter may be directed to the person whose signature appears below.

Dear Alderman Stamper:

We wanted to make you aware of our concerns about the issuance of a new liquor license for Magic Foods, 2879 N. 16th St. and to ask you to schedule a hearing in which we can participate in the June 30 Licensing Committee Hearing or at whatever time it may be scheduled.

For over a year we have been meeting with Balkar Singh about the disruptive behavior of customers who are purchasing alcoholic beverages from his store. That behavior includes illegal parking on a City lot just across from the store and across the street on a vacant lot and the street. And it also open drinking and drugging and drug sales on the premises and these spaces. Last summer grills were brought and the alley was blocked and the lot across the street used in continue these activities. They have also used these spaces to dump their garbage and as a public bathroom. And also the nearby basement entrance at the back of the church, a bit more sheltered space.

This store sits one short block from Hopkins Lloyd Community School and also adjacent to Hephatha Lutheran Church. The children of the school and the church pass by on their way to school and activities at Hephatha. This is not a safe or acceptable environment for them to have to experience, or anyone else for that matter, I am sure you would agree.

Our hope was that Mr. Singh could deal with the problems. He has been given assistance from Safe and Sound with popups that included resources that could be taken advantage of by this population and sponsored clean ups. AMANI and the Dominican Center representatives have created a handout to share with customers outlining parking regulations and times and consequences that could occur if these behaviors persist. We have cleaned up behind them. And he has been asked to call the police when people refuse his request that they leave. But he has not done so.

We now have the involvement of the Department of City Development who will create a barricade structure to block off the lot and the police Community Prosecution Unit has collaborated to ensure that cars that remain can be ticketed and towed. And a meeting was held at District 5 just last week with Mr. Singh and the store owner to confront the difficulties in having Mr. Singh call the police or deal with the issue by hiring a Security Guard that is bonded and from outside the community. A deadline was set for this Wednesday for him to have a Security Guard in place. Tony Harris from Safe and Sound has offered to provide him with a list of bonded and reliable Security Guard resources. Since he knows we will be opposing the renewal of the license this would be one positive step he could take toward addressing the complex set of circumstances that exist at the store.

In any event, we will want to be heard at the hearing. Some people will be submitting written testimony

which we will share with you. Some will want to be heard by zoom at the meeting and some of us with come person.

We asking you to see that we have the opportunity to be heard on this issue and to let us know the date of the Licensing Hearing where it will be addressed as soon as possible.

This report is written by Police Officer Calos Felixl, assigned to the License Investigation Unit, Days.

The Milwaukee Police Department's investigation regarding this application revealed the following:

1. On 01/24/21 at 5:39pm, Milwaukee Police were dispatched to 2879 N. 16th Street for a sick and injured complaint. Upon arrival, officers interviewed the caller who stated that she purchased merchandise from the establishment, left the store, and when she was walking down the steps, she slipped and hurt her knee. The employee was extremely cooperative and allowed officers to review the surveillance video.

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2. On 06/30/22 at 12:44p.m., officers were dispatched to 2879 N. 16th St. The caller stated a subject was in the store intoxicated, causing a disturbance and refusing to leave. The officers escorted the subject out of the store with no further incident.
3. On 07/08/22 at 7:31p.m., officers conducted a License Premise Check at 2879 N. 16th St. officers observed some food products without an expiration date and some food available for sale past the expiration date. The employees were cooperative and agreed to take the food off the shelves. The employees were asked to sign a standing complainant form, to which they agreed.
4. On 07/20/22 at 3:58p.m., officers were dispatched to a Shooting at 2879 N. 16th St. Investigation revealed subjects were shooting at each other outside of the business, when a

patron of the store exited the store and was caught in crossfire. The employees were cooperative with the investigation.

5. On 04/12/23 at 12:00p.m., officers were dispatched to a Property Damage at 2879 N. 16th St. The agent was cooperative and allowed officers to view video surveillance and it was determined to be a baseless complaint.
6. On 05/04/23 at 11:44a.m., officers were dispatched to a Trouble with Subject at 2879 N. 16th St. Officers were advised the subject had already left the scene prior to police arrival.

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7. On 05/15/23 at 8:23p.m., Milwaukee Police were dispatched to a Battery at 2879 N. 16th St. Investigation revealed an unknown subject was disorderly and making threats. The business was cooperative with the investigation and allowed officers to view video surveillance of the incident.
8. On 07/28/23 at 11:20a.m., Milwaukee Police were dispatched to a Shooting at 2904 W. Locust. A canvass of the neighborhood was conducted and officers were able to retrieve video from 2879 N. 16th which captured a portion of the incident. The employee was cooperative and allowed officers to retrieve video which assisted in the investigation.
9. On 05/24/24 at 3:33p.m., Milwaukee Police were dispatched to a Shooting at 2879 N. 16th St. On arrival officers located the victim who succumbed to their injuries. The victim was shot in the upper chest near their neck. The officers were allowed to view video surveillance, however, this incident occurred outside and the video did not capture the shooting. Prior to the shooting the victim was observed walking back and forth in front of the business. There appeared to be a blind spot in the exterior cameras in which it appeared people tend to congregate.
10. On 05/25/24 at 3:41p.m., Milwaukee Police conducted follow up at 2879 N. 16th St., regarding the Homicide that occurred on 05/24/24. The officers interviewed the agent regarding their finding of no calls for service for loitering at the location. The agent stated their employees call both the emergency and non-emergency number, however, there was no explanation as why the officer could not locate any calls for service made by the employees. The agent stated they ask subjects to leave, however, they return an hour later and often threaten the staff. The agent was advised they would set up a meeting with MPD and the business.
11. On 06/05/24, Milwaukee Police drafted a Nuisance Letter for 2879 N. 16th St., regarding the Homicide that occurred on 05/24/24. The letter was mailed via Certified mail to the property owner.

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12. On 10/18/24 at 7:11p.m., Milwaukee Police were dispatched to an Entry at 2879 N. 16th St. Investigation revealed an unknown subject was in the basement, unknown how they got in. The officers were able to remove the subject with no further incident. The business was cooperative.

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The following items are related to 2879 N. 16th Street.

13. On 10/08/25 at 10:00 a.m., officers attended a community meeting along with the owner. Issues with loitering and other quality of life concerns were brought to the owner's attention. He was advised by officers and community leaders on how the business could work to improve these concerns and tools that are available.
14. On 10/30/25, at 5:09 p.m., officers were dispatched to a Trouble with Subject complaint. The agent called regarding an intoxicated subject harassing customer and refusing to leave. The subject left prior to arrival.
15. On 11/02/25, at 7:17 p.m., officers were dispatched to a Trouble with Subject complaint. The agent requested officers remove a subject from the property. The subject complied without incident
16. On 12/04/25, at 3:49 p.m., an officer was dispatched to a Theft complaint. The actor was in the business smoking, causing a disturbance and walked out with a bottle of water they did not pay for. The agent requested information on obtaining a restraining order.
17. On 04/27/26, at 7:22 p.m., officers were dispatched to a Trouble with Subject complaint. The agent called regarding a subject drinking and smoking in front of the business. The subject was gone prior to arrival.
18. On 05/05/26, at 5:09 p.m., officers were dispatched to a Welfare Check. The agent called regarding a subject laying at the front door of the business. The subject was gone prior to arrival.
19. On 05/09/26, at 2:59 p.m., officers were dispatched to a Trouble with Subject complaint. A large group of subjects were observed loitering in the alley behind the business. The agent requested additional patrol to deal with the loitering issues.

LICENSED PREMISE REPORT

This license premise report is written by PO David LETTEER, assigned to District 5, Day Shift CPU.

On 10-08-25 at 10:00 a.m., PO NELSON, PO ROMO and myself attended a meeting that was hosted by Joyce Elwinger, who represents Hephatha Lutheran Church, located at 1720 W. Locust St. This meeting was to discuss the problems observed and reported at Magic Foods, located at 2879 N. 16th St. The agent/owner of Magic Foods, Balkar SINGH was in attendance, as well as other persons involved in the community.

At the meeting the police expressed that the store is having a problem with people loitering outside on the disabled ramp/railing/retaining wall, in front of the front door. Also expressed was the fact that people who park in the parking lot congregate and that those who congregate are now meeting in a vacant lot across the street from the store, on the north side of W. Locust St. There are numerous people, vehicles and even people with grills hanging out at the lot, which is owned by the City of Milwaukee at 2900 N 17th St.

During the meeting, SINGH stated he tries to move people who are outside of the business around, but that when he does that, the people don't do anything. He says he is calling the police, but no one cares. He went on to say that his son who is at the store, has gone up to vehicles, trying to get people to move, but no one moves. It was brought to SINGH that there was only one call for police and it was asked why the store is not calling the police more often. It was also brought up that Mr. Singh might be concerned about his license and how calling the police might impact his renewal. The reason the police were not called was because of the potential impact on his license. We advised him to call the police. It shows that the store is trying to stop the problem, instead of letting it continue and not do anything.

PO ROMO informed Mr. SINGH that he and his employees be trained on how to deal with people, that he and his staff should not confront people if there may be a problem. PO ROMO offered Mr. SINGH options that he could implement, such as the Fusus camera system, hiring a security guard that is licensed and bonded, not someone off the street or from the neighborhood to be security and everyone who works there be on the same page with customers.

Mr. SINGH stated the people who are at the store are there everyday, but that he does not know the people. It was brought up about having signage for loitering and no guns in the store. Mr. SINGH stated people come into the store with guns and that he can not do anything about that. We did inform him that people do have the right to carry concealed and open carry, but he can ask them to leave his business.

Safe and Sound was in attendance and it was brought up that corner stores do not sell healthy foods, but processed foods that are not good for the community. Tony HARRIS, the representative for Safe and Sound stated he has gone to the neighborhood and spoken to those who are hanging around the business and the people are open to help, but there is a lack of resources in the area, that is why people are at the store at 10am getting drunk.

Edgar, who represents the Tobacco Prevention program, working with LIU in compliance and training was also at the meeting. He informed Mr. SINGH what he does going out with LIU and underage teens to see if stores are in compliance with tobacco laws, but that he also puts on training for retailers and what to do in certain situations at stores again working with MPD. He stated there is another training in November and Mr. SINGH was open to the meeting. We informed him that he should bring not only himself, but all of his employees, again so everyone who works at the store could be on the same page.

Also in attendance was Crystal and Jarvis WEST from Dominican Center. Coming to the meeting, Crystal expressed that they were at Mr. SINGH's store just prior to the meeting. While at the store they had engaged those who are loitering outside of the store. It was mentioned that there were people in the parking lot of the store, drinking and that an employee was also outside with them drinking. It was also mentioned that those in the parking lot were smoking marijuana. Two of the people a male and female were smoking marijuana and that they had two smaller children in a vehicle. There was a female who was at the store, not clear if it was the same female smoking marijuana, but that the female when engaged started filming and talking about how people are at the business due to the owner giving people "credit" at the store. The female entered the store and walked behind the cash register counter continuing to film, pointing out on the video who goes to the store and has "credit". The term "credit" refers to people coming to the business to sell their food stamps. At this time this can not be confirmed.

The next person who was part of the meeting was Pastor Mary MARTHA, who is the pastor at Hephatha Lutheran Church. She believes that the sale of liquor is a bad influence on the kids going to and leaving Hopkins Lloyd School at 1503 W Hopkins St. The kids either going to school or going home have to walk by people who are loitering drinking alcohol. Pastor mentioned that the previous owner of the business had a relationship with the church in which the store did not sell alcohol during certain times during the day and that would be as the kids are going to school and leaving school. That the kids did not have walk by those drinking. Pastor wanted to renew that agreement with Mr. SINGH who was open to the idea. During the meeting the times that were suggested were no alcohol sales from 8am to 9am and then again from 2:30 pm to 3:00 pm.

It was also brought up that to help those who are hanging out around the store, that those at today's meeting come together for community pop ups, to hand out resources and engage the community in a positive manner.

As the meeting continued, people were having their input and the discussion was going the way of this is what Mr. SINGH is going to do. PO NELSON had to mention to everyone that everything mentioned today is nothing more than suggestions that Mr. SINGH could implement and do, that Mr. SINGH can run his business how he wants to. It was then mentioned that another meeting be held on November 5th, 2025 at 10:00 a.m. ELWINGER stated she would take everything mentioned today and work with Mr. SINGH and his business to see what happens before our next meeting.

Mr. SINGH does have a valid Class A Malt and Liquor license (ALQML 200964), Food (FOOD 16462) and Cigarette (CIG 1033904), which all are set to expire on 07-27-26.
