
This is to notify you that on October 4, 2012, the City's Public Safety Committee voted to recommend to the City's Common Council to not renew the Taxicab Permit at 3901 S. 85<sup>th</sup> St. based on the police report, criminal complaint, and judgment conviction.

On October 5, 2012, you were mailed a true and correct copy of the Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Recommendations of the Public Safety Committee with respect to the renewal application for a Taxicab Permit. You were further notified that the Milwaukee Common Council would consider the matter at its meeting of October 16, 2012 commencing at 9:00 a.m. in the Common Council Chambers on the third floor of City Hall, 200 East Wells Street, Milwaukee, Wisconsin. You were advised of your right to file written objections and to appear personally or by counsel to address the Common Council. You did appear and you did file written objections. You were represented by counsel.

Following consideration of the report of the Public Safety Committee and your written objections, the Common Council adopted the recommendation of the Public Safety Committee to not renew the Taxicab Permit at 3901 S. 85<sup>th</sup> St. based on the police report, criminal complaint, and judgment conviction.

If you previously paid the license fees you may be eligible for a refund, except for a portion of the fee that may be retained, by bringing in your receipt or filing an application for a refund within one year to date of Common Council action with the License Division, Room 105, City Hall.
