WHO WE ARE

We are a "Boots on The Ground" street outreach team whose mission is to provide life-sustaining support to those experiencing homelessness in Milwaukee County. Consistency and authenticity are key components which make our street outreach different from any other agency. The individuals we encounter are not clients, a case number or a statistic. They are our friends!

We directly interact with some of Milwaukee's most vulnerable residents, many of whom have no family support, nowhere to go and whom have lost their faith through broken systemic promises. The friendships and trust we build are key to paving their way to a better tomorrow.

SERVICES

Street Outreach:

With 2 community funded buses, we personally deliver food and basic necessities to an average of 100 friends per night, three nights per week -- even on holidays. In addition to street outreach, we are able to assist our friends with "cutting through the red tape" and often act as navigators to vital services.



We provide date encounter verifications to housing service providers which often leads to faster, permanent housing.

Whether it be obtaining shelter, employment, housing, AODA or mental health treatment, we act as the "extension cord" to service providers. We strive to break down systemic barriers and silos by adding new outreaches, partners and programs.

ADVOCACY

THE ROOT OF OUR MISSION

We believe that everyone deserves shelter /housing. They are a basic human right. Our grassroots advocacy has resulted in warming rooms opening at 32 degrees, restored funding for shelters, and improved processes for ER discharges for those experiencing homelessness. We advocate for awareness and accountability! Change is still needed!

COMMUNITY IMPACT

Since we started in Fall of 2015, through community support, we have been able to provide:

- 50,000+ hot "meals for the moment"
- 50,000+ bag "lunches for later"
- 400+ friends assisted into permanent housing
- 200+ "Showers of HOPE"
- 2,200 "safe sleeps" at warming centers
- 1,800+ transports to warming centers
