
REASON FOR REQUEST:

Montell Carter, a City of Milwaukee police officer, was in the scope of his employment, and operating a marked police squad car that was traveling east on West North Avenue. When Officer Carter stopped his squad car at the intersection of West North Avenue and North Martin Luther King Drive in order to allow a fire truck with its emergency lights and sirens activated to proceed northbound on North Martin Luther King Drive through the intersection, the uninsured motorist, Tashika Couch, rear-ended Officer Carter's squad car, causing the accident. As a result of the conduct of the uninsured motorist, there is liability on the City of Milwaukee pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 62.67 and the City of Milwaukee's Uninsured Motorist Self-Insurance Plan.

Officer Carter sustained permanent injuries to his neck and right shoulder. The claimed medical expenses and lost wages total \$288,413.70.
