To Whom It May Concern:

This letter is to provide notice to the City of Milwaukee ("City") of a claim from Deer District, LLC ("Deer District") due to damage to an electrical box located on 6<sup>th</sup> Street outside of Fiserv Forum. A Deer District security employee reported the damage to the electrical box after noticing it had shifted from its original position. Upon reviewing security footage, it is evident the damage was caused by a City of Milwaukee Department of Public Works snowplow (#30391) striking the electrical box at around 11:59am on December 1, 2025. I have attached photographs from the security footage of the truck and the damaged electrical box. We can provide a copy of the video upon request. I have also included the quote for \$63,290.00 received by Deer District to make the necessary repairs associated with the damaged electrical box. We request that the City provides full reimbursement of such costs.

Please advise as to next steps to resolve this matter so that Deer District can move forward to repair the electrical box as soon as possible. Thank you in advance for your prompt attention to this matter.

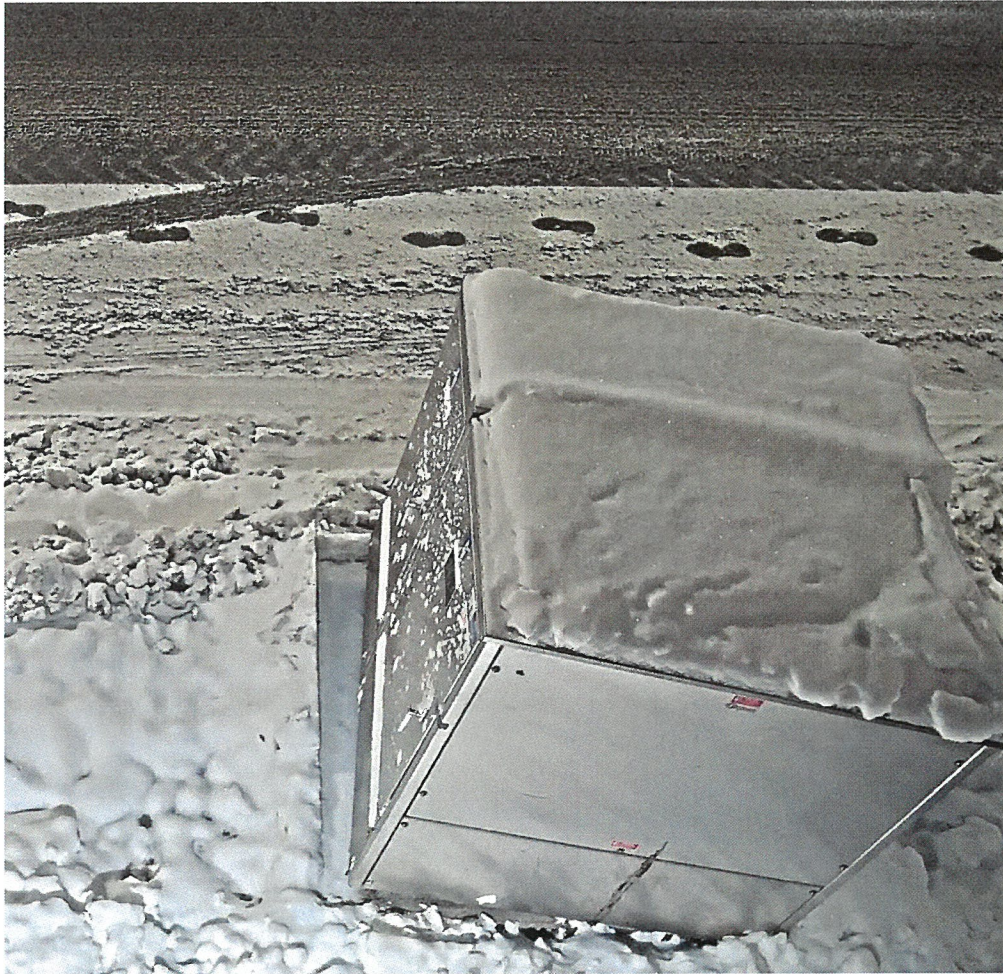
