This grant will aid the City of Milwaukee Tuberculosis Control Clinic (TBCC) in providing outreach, screening and other public health services to refugees. Refugees may have free health screening for tuberculosis, hepatitis, lead poisoning, pregnancy, parasites and other enteric diseases. Needed immunizations, health education and acquaintance with health care delivery systems are also provided. Foreign-born persons are a high-risk group for developing tuberculosis. In 2002, 87 refugees from many countries including Afghanistan, Bosnia, Croatia, Somalia, Russia and Yugoslavia were screened and 12 active cases of tuberculosis were found in foreign-born persons. its screening and treatment activities. TBCC encourages all new refugees to get the free health screening that includes screening for TB, hepatitis, lead,
