There is a possibility that your application may be denied for one or more of the following reasons: The recommendation of the committee regarding the application shall be based on evidence presented at the hearing. Per MCO 85-4-4, unless otherwise specified in the code, probative evidence concerning non-renewal, suspension or revocation may include evidence of the following: failure of the applicant to meet municipal qualifications, pending charges against or the conviction of any felony, misdemeanor, municipal offense or other offense, the circumstances of which substantially relate to the circumstances of the particular licensed or permitted activity, by the applicant or by any employee or other agent of the applicant. If the activities of the applicant involve a licensed premises, whether the premises tends to facilitate a public or private nuisance or has been the source of congregations of persons which have resulted in any of the following: disturbance of the peace; illegal drug activity; public drunkenness; drinking in public; harassment of passers-by; gambling; prostitution; sale of stolen goods; public urination; theft; assaults; battery; acts of vandalism including graffiti, excessive littering, loitering, illegal parking, loud noise at times when the licensed premise is open for business; traffic violations; curfew violations; lewd conduct; display of materials harmful to minors, pursuant to s. 106-9.6; or any other factor which reasonably relates to the public health, safety and welfare, or failure to comply with the approved plan of operation. It is the intention of the Common Council to suspend or non-renew the licenses if objectors provide testimony related to the factors enumerated in MCO 85-4-4 that the Common Council finds to be true by a preponderance of the evidence and/or police reports are found to be true by a preponderance of the evidence. The police reports and other attached documents relating to objections to the license are a part of this notice and expressly incorporated in this notice. The licensee should be prepared to address these matters at the hearing.

**Notice for applicants with warrants or unpaid fines:** Proof of warrant satisfaction or payment of fines must be submitted at the hearing on the above date and time. Failure to comply with this requirement may result in a delay of the granting/denial of your application.

Failure to appear at this meeting may result in the denial of your license. Individual applicants must appear only in person or by an attorney. Corporate or Limited Liability applicants must appear only by the agent designated on the application or by an attorney. Partnership applicants must appear by a partner listed on the application or by an attorney. If you wish to do so and at your own expense, you may be accompanied by an attorney of your choosing to represent you at this hearing.



This report is written by Police Officer Monreal, assigned to the License Investigation Unit, Days.

The Milwaukee Police Department's investigation regarding this application revealed the following:

1. On 07/10/2020 the applicant was cited in the City of Milwaukee for Boating-Adoption of State Statutes.

Charge: Boating-Adoption of State Statutes  
 Finding: Guilty  
 Sentence: Fined \$107.00  
 Date: 10/29/2021  
 Case: 21017809

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2. On 07/02/22 at 3:20pm, a subject walked into the Second District to report that her phone was stolen from 801 S. 2<sup>nd</sup> Street. She set her cell phone on the bar, walked away, and when she returned, it had been taken.
3. On 07/16/22 at 1:16am, Milwaukee Police were dispatched to 801 S. 2<sup>nd</sup> Street for a battery complaint. Investigation revealed that two subjects had an altercation regarding another subject. Security split the subjects up and police escorted the instigating party out.

4. On 07/24/22, a citizen walked into District Two to report his firearm was stolen from his vehicle. The citizen stated on 07/24/22 he parked his car on the street while he went to enjoy a night out at 801 S. 2<sup>nd</sup> St. The citizen stated he returned to his car at approximately 2:00a.m., and noticed his rear passenger side window and his firearm was missing.
5. On 10/02/22 at 1:21am, Milwaukee Police were dispatched to 801 S. 2<sup>nd</sup> Street for a subject with gun complaint. Officers could not contact the victim/caller who stated that security pointed a firearm at them and officers know that security are not armed at the tavern.
6. On 10/15/22 at 2:01am, Milwaukee Police were dispatched to 801 S. 2<sup>nd</sup> Street for a threat complaint. Investigation revealed that a highly intoxicated subject threatened to shoot security after they kicked him out of the establishment. The subject was not armed and stated he arrived at the location in a cab. All parties were advised.
7. On 12/27/22 at 9:47pm, Milwaukee Police were dispatched to 801 S. 2<sup>nd</sup> Street for a threat complaint. Investigation revealed that there is an ongoing issue between the tavern and a subject who refuses to leave the establishment. The subject was escorted out of the tavern and driven to a location he wished to go. All parties were advised.
8. On 03/28/23 at 1:30am, Milwaukee Police were dispatched to 801 S. 2<sup>nd</sup> Street for a trouble with subject complaint. Investigation revealed that a subject, who cut off his ankle monitoring devise, tried to give security counterfeit currency in order to enter the tavern. The subject could not be located and the currency was inventoried.
9. On 04/08/23 at 11:04pm, Milwaukee Police were dispatched to 801 S. 2<sup>nd</sup> Street for a sick/injured complaint. Investigation revealed that a subject fainted while dancing and fell on another person, severely injuring her leg. Medical was called for both subjects and this was a medical only call.
10. On 04/23/23 at 3:15am, Milwaukee Police were dispatched to 801 S. 2<sup>nd</sup> Street for a bomb threat. Investigation revealed that a subject from a "text now" application told police that there was a bomb that was going to explode at the location and the only person who could stop it lives at 2613 N. Oakland Avenue (a location which has had numerous "swatting" calls for service). Police checked the building and found no explosive device. The applicant was cooperative during the incident.

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11. On 03/10/24 at 3:15a.m., Milwaukee Police conducted a License Premise Check at 801 S. 2<sup>nd</sup> St. On arrival officers observed music playing and patrons consuming alcohol. The agent was on scene and stated they were under the impression they could remain open, due to Daylight Savings Time. The agent advised all the patrons the bar was closed and the establishment emptied out. Further investigation revealed the business was operating correctly due to Wisconsin State Statute 175.095(2). The business was very cooperative.

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12. On 09/07/24 at 3:15a.m., Milwaukee Police were dispatched to a Battery at 801 S. 2<sup>nd</sup> St. Investigation revealed an argument between two subjects, led to the victim's necklace being ripped off. A citation was issued to one of the subjects.
13. On 10/25/24 at 1:22a.m., Milwaukee Police were flagged down for a Trouble with Subject at 801 S. 2<sup>nd</sup> St. Investigation revealed two employees engaged in a verbal disagreement, which

led to pushing. One employee was escorted out by security. The business was cooperative with the investigation and allowed officers to view video surveillance of the incident.

14. On 03/15/25 at 11:15p.m., Milwaukee Police were dispatched to a Battery at 801 S. 2<sup>nd</sup> St. Investigation revealed an intoxicated patron was refusing to leave after being asked by security for inappropriate behavior, therefore, had to be physically escorted out. The intoxicated patron denied the behavior and was verbally aggressive with officers. The business was cooperative. (2 reports)

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15. On 06/08/25 at 2:34a.m., Milwaukee Police were dispatched to a Battery. Investigation revealed two suspects were being escorted out due to refusing to leave at closing time, began to batter security staff. Both suspects were taken into custody.

16. On 10/10/25 at 12:54a.m., Milwaukee Police were dispatched to a Battery, later deemed baseless. Investigation revealed the caller was causing a disturbance with other patrons and was asked to leave for the evening.

17. On 11/05/25 at 11:05a.m., Milwaukee Police conducted follow up regarding a Battery that occurred on 10/26/25 at approximately 2:30p.m., in front of the business. A victim reported they were involved in a physical altercation with an unknown suspect, causing a fractured hand. The business was cooperative and advised officers the Agent would be able to provide video surveillance.

18. On 11/23/25 at 2:14a.m., Milwaukee Police were dispatched to a Welfare Check. The business called regarding an intoxicated subject who was unable to keep their balance. MFD arrived on scene, administered NARCAN, at which time the subject became alert.

19. On 11/29/25 at 9:02a.m, Milwaukee Police were dispatched to a Burglary. Investigation revealed the business was the victim of a Burglary. The business was cooperative with the investigation and allowed officers to view video surveillance of the incident.

20. On 01/01/26 at 12:00a.m., Milwaukee Police were dispatched to 2166 N Holton for a Battery that occurred at 801 S. 2<sup>nd</sup> St. The caller stated they were pushed out of the business for no reason by a security guard. The security guard denied pushing the subject, and only stated they escorted them out for causing a disturbance.

21. On 03/22/26 at 2:30a.m, Milwaukee Police were dispatched to a Battery. The caller stated they reserved a private section and arranged bottle service of Champagne for the night with the Agent, however, during the night the bartender put Vodka on the table. The caller further stated the Agent confronted them about not paying the bill and a shoving match ensued. The Agent stated he leaned over to grab the caller's shoulder and lost their balance, unintentionally pushing a subject. The Agent stated they were made aware the extra bottle was the staff's error. Both parties stated they did not wish to press charges.

22. On 03/27/26 at 2:00a.m., Milwaukee Police were dispatched to a Call for Police. The business called regarding two subjects heard arguing inside the bathroom. The subjects were told to leave the business and were not on scene on officer's arrival.

This report is written by PO Hector A. MUNOZ assigned to District Two Late Power Shift Squad 2442 along with PO JOHNSON. We were in full duty Milwaukee Police Department issued uniform with our Milwaukee Police Department Badge on our outer most garment and equipped with audio and visual recording body worn cameras.

On Sunday, June 8, 2025, at approximately 2:34AM, PO JOHNSON and I (PO MUNOZ) responded to assist Squad 2416 SGT. Daniel STACHOVIK for Battery complaint at the address of 801 S 2nd St, (La Cage), which is located in the City and County of Milwaukee. Upon arrival I spoke to a subject later identified as Santiago S. TAMEZ (W/M, 9/14/70), who flagged down Squad 2416.

TAMEZ (security) stated when he and his staff were shutting down the bar, he tried to escort the subjects later identified as Andres MARTINEZ-REYES (W/M, 12/20/91) and Elmis FUENTES-RIBALTA (W/M, 9/25/86) outside the bar. TAMEZ stated MARTINEZ-REYES and FUENTES-RIBALTA (who were intoxicated) then assaulted him by punching him in the face causing an abrasion and redness followed by pushing and shoving when they were refusing to leave the business.

The business was cooperative with the investigation and TAMEZ allowed SGT. STACHOVIK and I to review the video surveillance footage capturing the incident. Upon reviewing the footage, observed TAMEZ along with his staff, attempting to escort MARTINEZ-REYES and FUENTES-RIBALTA out of the business. I observed MARTINEZ-REYES and FUENTES-RIBALTA fighting to stay inside by throwing multiple strikes towards TAMEZ resulting in TAMEZ getting struck by both subjects. I observed TAMEZ and his staff push MARTINEZ-REYES and FUENTES-RIBALTA outside the bar forcing them out, while MARTINEZ-REYES and FUENTES-RIBALTA were shoving TAMEZ and his staff to get back inside the business. After reviewing the footage, TAMEZ and the on-site staff were unable to recover the video regarding the camera's system requiring a password to download which none of the staff members know.

MARTINEZ-REYES and FUENTES-RIBALTA were taken into custody without further incident at 3:16AM and later transported to District Two for processing. It shall be noted that both parties involved were issued written Battery citations.

During my investigation, I observed the licenses posted which were up to date and I did not observe any violations in the licensed premise. Per the district community partnership unit this location is a designated nuisance premise. The business submitted an abatement plan to eliminate nuisance activity.

On Friday, October 10th, 2025, I was dispatched to 801 S 2nd St (La Cage), which is located in the City and the County of Milwaukee, for a battery complaint which was found to be baseless. Upon arrival, I spoke with the caller, identified as Shawn P. WALDO (M/W 10-6-1976), who stated he had stated transwomen are not women and was then chased out of the tavern by transwomen and other customers. WALDO stated there was no battery that had occurred and did not need any medical attention. I then spoke with the security for the evening, identified as Randy W. TIUTCZENKO (M/W 10-1-1981), who stated it was trans night at La Cage and they want the establishment to be an all-inclusive safe zone. TIUTCZENKO stated WALDO had made comments to the trans patrons that were not appropriate. TIUTCZENKO stated WALDO had caused an issue in the past for the same thing. TIUTCZENKO stated he did not want WALDO in the establishment for the evening. I spoke with the bartender, Roman E. KUZNETSOV (M/W 9-3-1980) and he stated WALDO was the one causing the issue. WALDO agreed to leave the establishment for the evening. The staff was cooperative throughout the course of the investigation and had a valid Class B Tavern License on display in the basement bar (BTAVN-0213293 Effective Date 6-17-2025 Expiration Date 6-16-2026).

This report is being written by PO Kadeem BLACKWOOD assigned to District 5, Early Shift.

On Wednesday, November 5th, 2025, I was instructed to conduct follow up regarding IR: C2511040110, at 801 S 2nd St (La Cage), which is located in the City and the County of Milwaukee. On Tuesday, November 4, 2025, an officer at the District took a walk-in Battery at the District 2920 N Vel R Phillips Ave which is in the City and County of Milwaukee. The victim identified as Joe T. MCDONALD (W/M 10/08/1993) stated at approximately 2:30 PM, at the location of 801 S 2nd St outside of La Cage in the City and County of Milwaukee an unknown suspect intentionally and without consent caused substantial bodily harm by picking him up and throwing him to the ground. MCDONALD stated that he was involved in a physical altercation with an unknown black male known by the nickname "EV." MCDONALD stated that he and the unknown subject got into an involved in a verbal argument during which the subject began making insulting remarks toward him. MCDONALD stated that the unknown subject called him poor. MCDONALD stated that the unknown male then threw money at him. MCDONALD stated that he then pushed the unknown subject. MCDONALD stated that the unknown subject responded by swinging at him with a closed fist, striking him and causing pain. MCDONALD stated that he was unsure where on his body the punch made contact. MCDONALD stated that both parties then engaged in a physical fight. During the altercation, the unknown subject allegedly picked him up and threw him to the ground, causing MCDONALD to sustain a fractured left hand. MCDONALD stated he was experiencing pain as a result of the injury. MCDONALD stated that during the struggle, he told the suspect to get off of him. MCDONALD stated the suspect then spit on him.

MCDONALD stated that he went to Aurora St. LUKES for medical treatment for his fractured left hand on October 26, 3:00 AM.

MCDONALD described "EV" as a:

Black male

6'0

Medium built

Unknown outfit

I spoke with the manager, Anthony (Tony) J. KASSEES (M/W 4-15-1980), who stated he does not have access to the surveillance camera system. KASSEES stated either Dave W. or Dave P. would have access to the cameras tomorrow at approximately 2:00 PM to 4:00 PM. KASSEES was cooperative with officers throughout the course of the investigation and no tavern violations were observed.
