DESIGNATE THROUGH HIGHWAY CLASSIFICATION
ON WEST CALUMET ROAD FROM NORTH 76TH STREET
EAST TO THE DEAD END EAST OF NORTH 67TH STREET

Dear Alderman Puente:

West Calumet Road from North 76th Street east to the dead end was designed to function as a through highway. This would be an extension of the present through highway on West Calumet Road from North 91st Street to North 76th Street, enabling the entire roadway to operate as it was designed.

Therefore, we recommend that this section of roadway be designated a through highway to facilitate the movement of through traffic on this roadway.

We will prepare the necessary legislation that will be heard at the next Public Safety Committee meeting, so that you may support it to final passage.
