To Whom It May Concern,

I am submitting testimony in opposition to the proposed 60th Street Data Center.

As someone who has lived in Milwaukee for a long time, worked as an educator, and actively participated in my neighborhood association, I care deeply about the direction our city is heading and the wellbeing of the people who live here.

This proposal does not feel like an investment in the community. It feels like a burden being placed on residents who already deal with rising costs of living. The possibility of increased energy costs being passed onto community members while a massive data center consumes enormous amounts of power is unacceptable.

I am also deeply concerned about the environmental and health impacts that come with facilities like this. Constant operational noise, round-the-clock light pollution, and the release of pollutants into the air would dramatically change the character of the surrounding neighborhoods. Residents should not have to worry about exposure to chemicals and carcinogens simply because they live near a corporate development project.

In addition, I believe property values in the area would decline as a result of this facility being placed so close to residential homes and community spaces. People deserve neighborhoods that feel safe, healthy, and livable.

I strongly oppose this proposal and would honestly consider relocating from the area if it is approved because I would no longer feel comfortable or safe living nearby.

Please prioritize the voices of Milwaukee residents over corporate interests.
