*In a nutshell, [the City's] support of MillerCoors Milwaukee Brewery has enabled a record setting summer for the brewery.*

*As a result, [we are]:*

- Localizing displaced volume from other breweries, the Miller-Coors joint-venture*
- Being operationally responsive to sales and marketing needs in helping MillerCoors out maneuver the competition this summer*
- Managing our costs effectively to become a more viable supply point within the MillerCoors brewery network in spite of our age and lay-out challenges*

*....we've seen our volumes increase nearly 20% this year, up over 30% in the months of July and August. We've hired over 100 new employees (full-time and temporary employees) and have positively impacted numerous local suppliers and businesses as we've assimilated the volume to the brewery. Most lines are running weekends and some seven days a week, 24 hours a day. We've done this while investing over \$26MM in the brewery and managed 62 active capital projects over the summer, many involving local equipment and service suppliers. We will end the year at 8.3 million barrels, up from 6.9 million barrels in 2008 and our preliminary figures for 2010 put us near 9 million barrels which hasn't been achieved since Milwaukee was the only brewery in the network.*
