There is a possibility that your application may be denied for one or more of the following reasons: The recommendation of the committee regarding the application shall be based on evidence presented at the hearing. Per MCO 85-4-4, unless otherwise specified in the code, probative evidence concerning non-renewal, suspension or revocation may include evidence of the following: failure of the applicant to meet municipal qualifications, pending charges against or the conviction of any felony, misdemeanor, municipal offense or other offense, the circumstances of which substantially relate to the circumstances of the particular licensed or permitted activity, by the applicant or by any employee or other agent of the applicant. If the activities of the applicant involve a licensed premises, whether the premises tends to facilitate a public or private nuisance or has been the source of congregations of persons which have resulted in any of the following: disturbance of the peace; illegal drug activity; public drunkenness; drinking in public; harassment of passers-by; gambling; prostitution; sale of stolen goods; public urination; theft; assaults; battery; acts of vandalism including graffiti, excessive littering, loitering, illegal parking, loud noise at times when the licensed premise is open for business; traffic violations; curfew violations; lewd conduct; display of materials harmful to minors, pursuant to s. 106-9.6; or any other factor which reasonably relates to the public health, safety and welfare, or failure to comply with the approved plan of operation. This report is written by Police Officer Penny Monreal, assigned to the License Investigation Unit, Days.

The Milwaukee Police Department's investigation regarding this application revealed the following:

1. On 04/01/23 at 3:55a.m., Milwaukee Police were dispatched to an Injured/Sick at 419 E. Wells St. On arrival it was determined this was a DOE call. Investigation revealed a citizen entered the restaurant and obtained a napkin from an employee then goes to the bathroom. Later in the video an employee is seen on camera going to the bathroom and the same citizen following the employee in. The employee exits the bathroom and the citizen remains inside. The employee is later observed on video attempting to enter the bathroom, however, the door was locked, therefore, the employee kicked the door repeatedly to gain entry. The agent was cooperative with the investigation and the employee was later arrested for inconsistencies with their story of what transpired.

#### LICENSED PREMISE REPORT

This supplemental report is written by P.O. Justin ARREDONDO, assigned to District One, Late Shift.

On Saturday, April 1st, 2023, at approximately 3:55 A.M., myself, in full-duty uniform, and operating marked MPD Squad 113, Squad 1330, and wearing department-issue AXON body camera) responded to meet Squad 1342; P.O. Kareem SLOANS, at an Injured/Sick complaint at 419 E. Wells St. This location was the Real Chili establishment. This was after I learned that the downed subject was listed as "PNB" with CPR in progress.

Upon arrival, I met with P.O. SLOANS and Squad 1312; Sergeant Marcin PAGACZ. As I was there, I collected the license premises information and made contact with the agent/owner by phone. The licenses are listed as: Class B Tavern - BTAVN, Sidewalk Class Diner 1. Next license was a Sidewalk Dining Facility Permit SD - 0001722 Class 1. The final license was a Food Dealer - Restaurant, Frest - 0018079, DHS Moderate, Sales \$20,001 - \$200,000. All three licenses were Effective 10-04-22, expiring 10-03-23. The Agent/owner was later identified as Stephen J. KASTELIC (w/m, 06-26-81). There was also a Certificate of Occupancy, Issued 03-16-04 #541824, Type-A Sit Down Restaurant, with an 80-person occupancy. I also was tasked to attempt locate a form of identification on the deceased. I located 5 separate cards in the deceased's front right jacket pocket. I found a Wisconsin I.D. for Charles E. EVANS (b/m, 07-19-63), as well as a Quest Card with his name, a Quest Card with the name of name of Cavon I. GREEN, and an MCTS Bus Card.

Sometime later, KASTELIC arrived on-scene, who was able to provide video playback of how this incident transpired. I viewed this video in the basement of the restaurant. The video was viewed on "Camera9". It should be noted that the date/time was incorrect, depicting a date of 01-23-23, and a time difference of 2 hours and 26 minutes. The timestamps depicted below are taken from the visible timestamp on the recording.

At 4:02, EVANS is seen entering the business, and sits down for moment, and acquired what appeared to be a napkin from one of the employees and goes into the bathroom at 4:03. At 4:07 A.M., EVANS leaves the bathroom, and uses the store phone to conduct a phone call. EVANS leaves the camera view at 4:12, and is presumed to have left the building. At 4:31, EVANS is seen following KING toward the rear bathroom hallway. KING is seen opening the bathroom door and walks in, followed by EVANS, and the door fully closes. At 4:34, KING is seen leaving the bathroom alone, with EVANS still inside. KING goes back to work until 5:48 A.M., in which KING is seen trying to open the bathroom door. It appeared as the door was locked, as KING is seen trying to pry the lock open, and kicking the door repeatedly until forced

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entry is gained at 5:49. KING goes into the bathroom for a minute and comes out. KING is seen repeatedly pacing between the bathroom and the back, with the manager also checking periodically. At 6:17, MFD is seen walking to the bathroom.

I passed this information onto the P.O. SLOANS and Sgt. PAGACZ, who later notified CIB. This information was later conveyed to CIB upon arrival. It should be noted that due to technological difficulties, I only viewed Camera9 and no other views prior to advising other officers of my discovery. CIB informed me they would take care of the other views, and not to concern myself with it. I remained on-scene to await the arrival of the medical examiner's transport team and was left with Toe Tag Number 342513. At 7:05 A.M., the Medical Examiner Transport Team arrived, and later transported EVANS to their facility.

KASTELIC was fully cooperative in this investigation, but it should be noted that the listed employee was arrested because the statement he provided the police about what occurred was proven false during the review of the surveillance video.



Please make such requests no later than one business day prior to the start of the meeting. You are not required to attend the hearing, but please see the information below if you would like to provide testimony. Once the Licenses Committee makes its recommendation, this recommendation is forwarded to the full Common Council for approval at its next regularly scheduled hearing.

# Important details for those wishing to provide information for the Licenses Committee to consider when making its recommendation:

- 1. The license application is scheduled to be heard at the above time. Due to other hearings running longer than scheduled, you may have to wait some time to provide your testimony.
- 2. You must appear in person and testify as to matters that you have personally experienced or seen. (You cannot provide testimony for your neighbor, parent or anyone else; this is considered hearsay and cannot be considered by the committee.)
- 3. No letters or petitions can be accepted by the committee (unless the person who wrote the letter or the persons who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify).
- 4. Persons opposed to the license application are given the opportunity to testify first; supporters may testify after the opponents have finished.
- 5. When you are called to testify, you will be sworn in and asked to give your name, and address. (If your first and/or last names are uncommon please spell them.)

- 6. You may then provide testimony.
- a. Include only information relating to the above license application.
- b. Include only information you have personally witnessed or seen.
- c. Provide concise and relevant information detailing how this business has affected or may affect the peaceful enjoyment of your neighborhood.
- d. If by the time you have the opportunity to testify, the information you wish to share has already been provided to the committee, you may state that you agree with the previous testimony. Redundant or repetitive testimony will not assist the committee in making its recommendation.
- 7. After giving your testimony, the members of the Licenses Committee and the licensee may ask questions regarding the testimony you have given or other factors relating to the license application.
- 8. Business Competition is not a valid basis for denial or non-renewal of a license.
