
Re: Resolution relating to the Permanent Historic Designation of the property at 2590 and the property at 2594-2598 South Superior Street, the Beulah Brinton House, in the 14th Aldermanic District.

At a public hearing held on July 2, 2018, the Historic Preservation Commission, by a vote of four (4) ayes and two (2) excused, recommended permanent historic designation of the above district in accordance with provisions of Section 320-21-9 of the Milwaukee Code of Ordinances, based upon criteria of s. 320-21-3-e-3, e-5 and e-9.

Section 320-21-9 of the Milwaukee Code of Ordinances provides that the Common Council shall review the recommendation of the commission and take final action. You will be notified of the time and location of the Common Council Zoning, Neighborhoods & Development Committee hearing if you wish to speak further on the matter.
