Granville's focus is community development and YK is on renting out apartments. There seems to be no honest and sincere concern for the safety, caring and compassion for the Seniors and how this project will impact the wellbeing of the Residents.

- Who approved the sale of this property to a company with no medical license?
- Assisted Living Residents were heartbroken when their caregiver Bria dumped them and they only had 30 days to find a home
- Was there in depth investigation of the future intentions and "Hidden Agenda" of YK?
- YK is not prepared to make massive changes when they can not manage current Resident issues
- Dining service uncertainties and perhaps ended.
- 24/7 Front desk questionable availability is uncertain.
Concerns on receiving packages and medication
- 911 and EMT chaos, if no one is at that position 24/7 for guidance

- Only have 2 security guards staffed to cover 3 massive buildings 24/7
- Can you legally charge an established renter \$300 dollars more than a new renter?
- New Residents in the North building "Multi Generation Families" were lied to when given the option of the same apartment type move to the East Building. YK is renting out those East apartments, and not holding them as promised. They are trying to stuff Residents into one room studio apartments.
- YK is being deceptive and not telling the new residents their plans and changes.
- Still no written communications or plans
