

REASON FOR REQUEST:

Jeffrey Cook, a City of Milwaukee police officer, was in the scope of his employment and operating a City of Milwaukee vehicle that was traveling on West Fiebrantz Avenue. As the City vehicle was backing up towards an alley, the uninsured motorist, who was fleeing from the police and traveling in reverse northbound out of the alley, failed to yield the right-of-way, causing the accident. As a result of the conduct of the insured motorist, there is liability on the City of Milwaukee pursuant to Wis. Stat. §62.67 and the City of Milwaukee's Uninsured Motorist Self-Insurance Plan.

Officer Cook sustained injuries to his head, neck and back. The claimed medical expenses and lost wages total \$4,393.17.
