Subject: Common Council Resolution File Number 090959

Dear Honorable Members:

Returned herewith is Common Council Resolution File Number 090959, being an amendment to a special privilege for change of ownership for a fence with brick columns and private light fixtures and for addition of a covered walk for the premises at 2053 North Martin L. King Jr. Drive.

Cornell Westmoreland requested permission to keep and maintain a fence with columns and two excess door swings to encroach into the public right-of-way. Permission for items was granted in 1993 under Common Council Resolution File Number 930404. Subsequently, the Milwaukee Code of Ordinances was amended so that the door swings are now permitted to project into the public right-of-way. A site visit revealed the presence of a covered walk and private light fixtures in the south sidewalk area of West Lloyd Street.

We are not aware that the presence of said items has had or will have an adverse effect on the general use of the public right-of-way. We have, therefore, prepared the attached special privilege resolution, which, if adopted, will amend the ownership of the above special privilege and will formally allow said items to continue to occupy the public right-of-way.
