Dear Mr. Fromm and Mr. Teper:

You are hereby notified that the Milwaukee Common Council will hold a hearing on June 10, 2008, commencing at 9:00 a.m., or as soon thereafter as this matter may be heard, in the Common Council chambers on the third floor of City Hall, 200 East Wells Street, Milwaukee, Wisconsin to consider the renewal of the mobile home park license held by you as agent for Collegiate Mobile Home Park LLC for the premises located at 6160 South 6th Street in the City and County of Milwaukee, Wisconsin.

Attached you will find a copy of the Report of the Licenses Committee which includes its Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Recommendation, recommending non-renewal of the mobile home park license. The recommendation is the result of a hearing held on May 28, 2008 and objections from the Department of Neighborhood Services and the Milwaukee Police Department.

You may file written objections to the report of the Licenses Committee. If you file a written objection to the report you may also appear before the Milwaukee Common Council to make oral arguments supporting your written objections. Any written objections to the Committee's Report must be filed with the City Clerk by 4:45 p.m. on June 5, 2008. You or a legal representative may then also appear at the Common Council meeting and request an opportunity to address the Common Council for approximately five (5) minutes to present an oral argument on your own behalf.
