Dear Council Members:

Returned herewith is a document filed by Attorney Laurie Eggert for attorney's fees for representing Police Officers Jeff Cook, Shawn Lauda, Kurt Kezeske, Jason Kane, Rodney Lloyd, James Jackson, Alvin Hannah and Carlos Rutherford. The claim is in the amount of \$6,331.00 including \$39.00 in disbursements for 57.20 hours of service billed at the rate of \$110.00 per hour. We ask that this matter be introduced and referred to the Committee on Judiciary & Legislation.

We have reviewed this claim and advise that in our opinion, the time spent was reasonable. Legal representation was occasioned by a criminal investigation. No criminal charges were brought against the police officers on whose behalf this claim was filed.

As we have advised you under similar circumstances in the past, the Common Council has discretion to reject this claim or to pay it in whole or in part. Sec. 895.35, Stats., *Bablitch and Bablitch v. Lincoln County*, 82 Wis. 2d 574 (1978).


Dear Mr. Leonhardt:

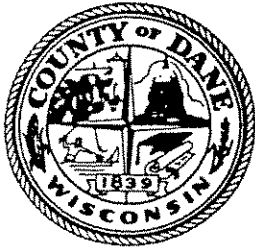

Re: Inquest Into the Death of Mario Mallett

Dear Chief Jones:

I am the first assistant district attorney in Dane County, Wisconsin, and the senior assistant among Wisconsin assistant district attorneys. I was assigned as special prosecutor in the above-captioned action because of the appearance of conflict at the Milwaukee County District Attorney's office had -- one of its assistant district attorneys is married to one of the officers involved.

The inquest jury was selected on Tuesday, March 5, 2002, with the trial commencing immediately thereafter. The inquest jury reached a verdict of accidental death at approximately 4:15 p.m. on Wednesday, March 6, 2002, after approximately two hours of deliberation.

Lieutenant Scott Schaefer was assigned by the Milwaukee Police Department as one of the primary investigating officers. I met with Lieutenant Schaefer on Monday, the 4th of March, and he sat through the inquest trial. I found the lieutenant to be unusually insightful and extremely helpful in my presentation to the jury. Without his gracious assistance, including but not limited to supplying me with diagrams and copies of the police department rules and regulations, my presentation to the jury would be significantly hampered. In addition, he is a bright, pleasant individual with a well-developed sense of humor. Were he in Madison, I would look forward to working with him on every case time and time again. You're lucky to have him.

The following officers were either directly or indirectly involved in the fact situation which gave rise to the inquest: Officers Carlos Rutherford, Alvin Hannah, James L. Jackson, Rodney Lloyd, Jason Kane, Kurt Kezeske, Sean Lauda, and Jeffrey Cook. The supervising officer at the scene, as you know, was Tayo Adeneken.

With respect to each and all of the officers, they were extremely cooperative and helpful in the preparation of the inquest in meeting with me, several of them on their own time on March 4, 2002. In addition, each officer showed up in the proper uniform and in a timely manner for the trial. Each of the officers in their testimony responded directly to questions in a very articulate manner.

I have been in this business 31 years, and I like to think that I'm reasonably adept at judging the credibility of a witness. Though their testimony differed on small details, as you would expect any witnesses to differ, I am absolutely confident that each officer told the absolute and complete truth. In my judgment, each is a credit to the Milwaukee Police Department. No officer engaged in any conduct that could be remotely considered criminal in nature. The inquest exonerated all officers.

I realize that it is not my judgment call to make, but I do understand that a number of the officers were taken off the street on an administrative basis following this incident. Based upon the evidence available to me, I would encourage and recommend that they immediately be returned to their normal duties.

In particular, with respect to Officer Cook, I understand that he is currently on a sergeant's panel but any decision on a promotion for him has been delayed. I further understand that that panel lapses in July of 2002.


Officer Cook, in my judgment, based upon my 31 years of experience in dealing with law enforcement officers, would make a wonderful sergeant. I am, of course, unaware of his prior record with the department, but based upon the actions he undertook during the course of the incident that gave rise to the inquest, I would heartedly recommend that he be promoted to sergeant.

All officers at the scene followed the directions of the supervising sergeant. I would note that those directions in one or two occasions appeared to be contrary to the written rules and regulations of the Milwaukee Police Department, though I appreciate that officers at scenes are given the discretion to act according to the best interests of everyone in any given situation.
