File #021015 is a resolution authorizing the transfer and expenditure of \$5,000 from the Neighborhood Commercial District Street Improvement Fund for the National Avenue Commercial District Enhancement Project. (DCD)

Background

- 1. Since 1995, the Layton Boulevard West Neighborhood Association ("LBWN") has invested time and resources into the improvement of the National Avenue commercial neighborhood district.
- 2. Historically, the City of Milwaukee has financially supported the LBWN Association's initiatives.

Discussion

- 1. The Layton Boulevard West Neighborhood Association, having undertaken the National Avenue Commercial District Enhancement project is proposing enhancements along National Avenue in the existing National Avenue commercial neighborhood district.
- 2. LBWN seeks \$5,000 for the purpose of installing banners on National Avenue between South 31st and 39th Streets.
- 3. To qualify for City assistance, LBWN plans to invest \$5,000 toward the proposed enhancements.
- 4. Adoption of this resolution authorizes a \$5,000 fund transfer and expenditure from the Neighborhood Commercial District Street Improvement Fund to install banners as proposed in the National Avenue Commercial District Enhancement Project.
- 5. Today, the FMIS system reports a Neighborhood Commerical District Street Improvement Fund balance of \$533,318.80.

Fiscal Impact

This file authorizes a \$5,000 grant transfer and expenditure from the 2002 Neighborhood Commercial District Street Improvement Fund capital account.
