1. On 05/28/2010 the applicant was cited in the City of Milwaukee at 1321 N. Edison St for Disorderly Conduct.

2. On 01/25/2020 at 2:40am officers observed 3 subjects exit the north side door of White Tail, 1110 N. Old World Third St. The officers also observed a subject enter the bar through this door. The officers entered the business and observed people sitting at the bar with glasses of alcohol. The bartender stated he was unable to clear the bar at closing. The officers cleared the bar and advised this report would be filed.

3. On 02/13/21 at 12:15am, Milwaukee Police, along with the Wisconsin Department of Health Services, conducted a license premise check at 1110 N. MLK Drive. The follow violations were observed; no 6-foot spacing of patrons and no face coverings. The applicant was on scene and advised of the violations.
4. On 07/08/21 at 10:30pm, Milwaukee Police were dispatched to 1110 N. MLK Drive for a fight complaint. Investigation revealed that a patron was inside the establishment wanting to fight another patron who accidently bumped into him. When security tried to escort the patron out, he hit security and a fight broke out inside the tavern causing chairs and tables to be knocked over. The fight eventually headed outside into the street and police broke up the incident.
5. On 07/15/21 at 12:50am, A Milwaukee Police Officer was asked by a Milwaukee Police Sergeant to investigate a battery which occurred at 1110 N. MLK Drive. Investigation revealed that a patron was being disorderly inside the tavern and was asked to leave by security. After being escorted outside the establishment, the patron used a racial slur and spit on security. Security then shoved and punched the patron before closing the front door.
6. On 07/21/21 at 4:35pm, Milwaukee Police were dispatched to a battery which occurred at 1110 N. MLK Drive. Investigation revealed that a patron left his debit card inside the tavern and security let him in to close out his bill. His female companion, who was not allowed inside, waited for her companion to leave, stepped in the open doorway, and began swinging at security. The male companion steppes between the female and security and the female falls to the ground clear of the tavern door. Security then shuts and secures the tavern door.

7. On 01/01/22 at 3:47am., officers were dispatched to a Trouble with Subject at 1110 N. Old World Third. Investigation revealed two patrons were smoking marijuana in the tavern and asked to leave. The patrons became verbally and physically aggressive to staff and were escorted out of the establishment.
8. On 05/09/22 at 10:58pm., officers were dispatched to a Fight at 1110 N. Old World Third. On arrival officers observed security breaking up a fight inside the establishment and escorting the subjects out. Management was cooperative with the investigation.
9. On 08/28/22 at 1:39am., officers assigned to Code Red, heard a loud bang in the area of 1100 N. Martin Luther King Jr Dr. Investigation revealed two patrons began to argue inside the bar and were escorted out by security. Once outside, the argument escalated and the suspect, who admitted to being inside the tavern with his firearm, pulled his firearm out and fired one round into the ground. The suspect who was highly intoxicated, was arrested and his firearm and a single casing that was located outside of 1110 N. Martin Luther King Jr Dr., in the parking lot, was placed on inventory. A victim, who was inside the tavern was treated for a gun shot wound to his leg at a local hospital. A witness was interviewed and stated they observed the two subjects fighting inside the tavern and attempted to escort them outside, when he observed the suspect pull the firearm out and point it at the neck of the second subject, then point it at the ground and fire a single round. The establishment had been notified in the past by Police, they should be checking patrons for weapons prior to allowing them in to the establishment.

10. On 07/18/22 at 1:19am., officers were in the area of 1100 N. Martin Luther King Jr Dr., and monitoring bar close, when they observed 20-25 subjects fighting in front of 1110 N. Martin Luther King Jr Dr. A victim, who was bleeding from the nose, stated he was walking out of the bar and observed an argument outside, when he was struck by an unknown subject. The victim, who was highly intoxicated became uncooperative and refused medical or police service. Officers interviewed the manager, who stated he didn't know what happened and does have working security cameras, however, they would not have captured the incident in the area it occurred. Management was cooperative and security did make an attempt to break up the fight.

INITIAL INVESTIGATION

This report is written by P.O. Lafayette TURMAN, assigned to District One, Late Power Shift.

On Friday, January 1st, 2022, I was assigned to Squad 1431 with PO. Andrew DUDLEY. We were operating a marked black and white Milwaukee Police Department Chevrolet Tahoe (Car 331) equipped with red/blue emergency lights and audible siren. We were in full MPD uniforms with badges and nameplates affixed to our outermost garments. We were equipped with body worn cameras, which were activated and captured this incident.

At approximately 3:47 PM while monitoring New Year's Eve bar close on N Old World Third St. I responded to a Trouble with Subject incident at the White Tail Bar located at 1110 N Old World Third St Milwaukee WI 53203 (which is in the City and County and State of Wisconsin). Upon arrival I observed that Milwaukee Police Sgt. Tyler KIRKVOLD had separated a Hispanic male subject who was forced out of the White Tail bar. During the investigation I had spoken with the White Tail Manager who identified himself as Alberto VALIE (W/M 09-26-90).

INTERVIEW of Alberto VALIE: MANAGER

VALIE stated that at approximately 3:25 AM he observed (2) two Hispanic male subjects sitting at the back of the bar and smoking Marijuana. VALIE stated not only could he see both subjects smoking but he could smell it. VALIE stated that he then informed his security about the situation and they approached the two subjects. VALIE stated as security was escorting the two subjects out they began to get verbally aggressive. VALIE stated that as the subjects left the bar a Hispanic female approached the two subjects in the doorway and was nudged by Security staff as they were trying to get the two subjects to leave. VALIE stated the two subjects continued to be verbally aggressive and then tried to fight White Tail staff.

I was operating a marked black and white Milwaukee Police Department Chevrolet Tahoe (Car 331) equipped with red/blue emergency lights and audible siren. I was in full MPD uniform with my badge and nameplate affixed to my outermost garment. I was equipped with a body worn camera, which was activated and captured this incident.

On 05/09/22 at approximately 10:58 PM while monitoring bars on N Old World Third St, I responded to a fight at Whitetail Milwaukee Bar located at 1110 N Old World Third St Milwaukee WI, 53203 (which is in the City and County of Milwaukee). Upon arrival I observed security breaking up a fight inside the bar and making subjects involved leave the premises.

While attempting to gather more information regarding this incident, the subjects who were involved went to another bar causing a disturbance. After speaking with the subjects involved in the fight and conducting a wanted check through WI DOT it was revealed one of the subjects had a MCSO warrant and was arrested on scene.

Manager on scene, identified as Alberto VALLE (W/M 09-26-90) was informed that a tavern report regarding this incident would be filed. Staff and the manager on scene were cooperative with the police.

INITIAL INVESTIGATION

This report was written by P.O. Shawn SWITZER, assigned to District One, Late Power Shift Squad 1430.

On Sunday, August 28, 2022 at approximately 1:39 am P.O. Andrew DUDLEY and I were on a Code Red assignment at 1100 N Martin Luther King Jr Dr. While monitoring the street I heard a loud bang sound which sounded like it was coming from north of my location. P.O. DUDLEY and I began to run towards the direction of the bang. While running north bound on the 1100 block of N Martin Luther King Jr Dr, I observed a large group of people running south bound toward me. I heard numerous subjects state "they're shooting over there!" as they ran past me. The people appeared to be running from the parking lot, which is located on the north side of Whitetail Bar located at 1110 N Martin Luther King Jr Dr.

P.O. DUDLEY and I were accompanied by Squad 5448, P.O. Shelisa CARSON and P.O. Kimberly KANEKEO, and Squad 5413, Sgt. Miguel CORNEJO who also ran towards the sound of the bang.

P.O. DUDLEY, P.O. CARSON, P.O. KANEKEO, Sgt. CORNEJO, and I began to search the area for injured subjects and the actor who discharged the firearm. I did not observe anyone who was struck by gunfire. While I was searching the lot, I observed P.O. CARSON and P.O. KANEKEO with their service pistols pointed at a subject who had his hands in the air. They were giving him commands, which the subject complied with. I holstered my service pistol, and arrested the subject. This subject was identified as Joel A VILLARREAL (w/m 10-16-84) by his Wisconsin I.D. While placing handcuffs on VILLARREAL I observed a black semi-automatic handgun tucked inside the waist band of his pants. P.O. DUDLEY removed the firearm, cleared it, and secured it inside of a locked squad car. The firearm was a black, Glock model 29, 10mm. The pistol did have a live cartridge inside of the chamber and the magazine was loaded with 8 unfired cartridges.

The firearm and unfired cartridges were recovered and conveyed to District One where they were placed on Inventory. The firearm was placed on inventory # 22031773 and the unfired cartridges was placed on inventory # 22031774 PP-32 issued.

The scene was secured by Officers on scene.

P.O. CARSON and P.O. KANEKEO spoke with witnesses on scene, please see their supplemental reports for details.

and has a large parking lot located on the north side of it. Whitetail bar has an entrance/exit located on the northside of the building. This door is an aluminum framed double door and exits to the parking lot and may have surveillance cameras inside and outside of the building. A single, 10mm casing was located laying approximately 2 inches from these doors. The casing was recovered by P.O. KANEKEO and placed on inventory # 22031767

P.O. Benjamin DELANEY conveyed VILLAREAL to District One for processing.

At approximately 3:52 am Squad 1330, P.O. Irvin HERNANDEZ-MAESTRE responded to the V.A. Hospital, located at 5000 W National Ave for a walk in shooting victim. The victim was identified as Alfredo MARTINEZ-MARTINEZ (w/m 07-23-94). MARTINEZ stated he was inside of White Tail bar when he heard a gun shot. When he returned home, he removed his pants and observed an injury to his leg. Please see the supplemental report for further details.

This incident may have been captured on surveillance video outside of the building. However, we were unable to locate anyone at the time who had access to the cameras. We were informed that the building manager would be able to retrieve the video at a later date. The building manager's name is Thomas and can be reached at 414-349-2415.

The manager of White Tail Bar is Alberto VALLE (w/m 09-26-90) and is able to view the video inside of the bar. His phone number is 414-732-3363.

It should be noted that White Tail's management has been notified in the past by Uniformed Police Officers that they should be checking their patrons for weapons prior to allowing them entry into their establishment.

During a mirandized interview of VILLARREAL he stated he arrived to White Tail already highly intoxicated, he stated he was inside of the bar with his wife and while inside another patron pushed his wife which escalated into an altercation with the subject. VILLARREAL stated the altercation ended up outside, he stated he observed the subject holding a bottle and coming towards him. VILLARREAL stated he pulled his gun out and fired one round into the ground. VILLARREAL stated the shooting occurred outside in the parking lot.

It should be noted that this incident started inside of the bar, and VILLARREAL did have his firearm on him while inside of the bar.

The following paragraph is a summary of P.O. CARSON's supplemental report:

A witness to this incident, Christopher J MENSAH (b/m 05-27-88) was interviewed by P.O. CARSON, he stated that he observed two individuals begin to fight. He stated he directed them to the exit located on the north side of the building and attempted to escort them outside. He stated at some point during the fight he observed VILLARREAL pull a firearm out and point it at the neck of the second subject. MENSAH stated VILLARREAL then pointed the firearm towards the ground and fired one round into the ground.

INITIAL INVESTIGATION

This report was written by P.O. Shawn SWITZER, assigned to District One, Late Power Shift Squad 1430.

On Monday, July 18, 2022 at approximately 1:19 am P.O. Andrew DUDLEY and I were parked at 1100 N Old World Third St monitoring bar close. P.O. DUDLEY and I observed a fight occur at 1110 N Old World Third St (Whitetail Bar). We pulled up to the fight and exited our vehicle. I observed approximately 20-25 subjects fighting on the sidewalk next to the bar. I observed a white male who was getting up off the ground and bleeding from his nose. This male was later identified as Antonio ORDONEZ (w/m 06-14-95). ORDONEZ stated he was walking out of the bar and saw an argument outside. He stated when he was walking past the argument he was hit in the face by an unknown subject. He stated he did not have any prior contact with the individual who struck him and did not know why they hit him. I called for medical attention for ORDONEZ and Bell ambulance arrived on scene. ORDONEZ was highly intoxicated and became uncooperative with Police. He walked away from the bar saying he would be fine and did not need police assistance.

I did not observe the subject who struck ORDONEZ, I spoke with the manager of Whitetail Bar Alberto VALLE (w/m 09-26-90) who stated he did not know what happened, however he observed a fight outside of the location. He stated they have working surveillance cameras in the bar and at the west entrance of the location, however they did not have any cameras in the area the fight occurred.

While on scene I conducted a check of Whitetail's licenses. Whitetail has a valid Class B Tavern license which expires on February 7, 2023.

The management of Whitetail was cooperative with our investigation and the bar's security did make an attempt to break up the fight.


