Consistent with its policy, the City Attorney's Office has refused to represent them, and as they were performing the duties of their office at the time of the events giving rise to the incident, the claim is hereby made on their behalf for the indicated legal fees. This incident involved an arrest after a pursuit.

The MPD initiated a criminal investigation in which the officers initially declined to give a statement without counsel. When they requested counsel, IAD compelled POs Marshall, Randazzo, Witkowski and Buddenhagen to give a statement concerning the incident after issuing a PI-21.

Later, the MPD decided not to issue criminal charges against the officers. Attached is a copy of the clearance report and an itemization of the time and services rendered.

This report was dictated by Lieutenant of Detectives Mary Hoerig, of the Criminal Investigation Unit/Internal Affairs Division (CIU/IAD), Early Shift.

### **ALLEGATION:**

The complainant, Andre M. WARD, alleges that unknown Milwaukee police officers struck him in the head and body with their fists causing him pain and injury.

# **INVESTIGATION:**

Detective Michael CARLSON did meet with Sgt. Ivory BRITTON on Tuesday, February 20, 2001 at District seven in regards to an alleged battery complaint. Sgt. BRITTON explained that P.O. Christopher MARSHALL and P.O. Kevin EYRE became involved in a high speed pursuit of a vehicle, in which the complainant had been an occupant. P.O. MARSHALL did pursue Andre WARD on foot from the sight of where the vehicle crashed. Officer MARSHALL attempted to apprehend the subject at which time the subject struck Officer MARSHALL twice in the head with a closed fist causing Officer MARSHALL to deliver focused strikes and use O.C. on the subject to get him into custody.

Andre WARD was interviewed by Detective CARLSON at which time he confirmed the statement given above. He states that the officer struck him in the face and sprayed him several times with O.C. spray. He states that the officer then put him in handcuffs and again hit him in the jaw while he was still on the ground. He goes on to state that he was struck several times in the back of the head and kicked in the left side of the body. WARD states as he was being taken to the squad car that he was again hit several times by other officers walking him to that location. Sgt. BRITTON indicated that the other officers listed in this complaint were members of the other squads that had responded to the chase.

On Tuesday, February 20, 2001 a charge of Battery to Police Officer was issued against Andre WARD by the Milwaukee County District Attorney's office. All other officers indicated in this complaint refused to make a statement without legal counsel present.

# **CONCLUSION:**

Deputy District Attorney Jon REDDIN on Tuesday, March 20, 2001 reviewed this case at which time he declined any charges against the officers, stating that he could not find any criminal action on the part of the officers. This case is cleared as warrant refused.
