(Intersection of West Center Street and North 22<sup>nd</sup> Street)

Dear Council Members:

The Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WISDOT) has informed the City of Milwaukee that the project has been approved for funding under the Safe Routes to School (SRTS) program. The project consists of constructing curb bump outs at crosswalks, installing high visibility crosswalk pavement marking and signage, relocating bus stops and install traffic signals at the intersection of West Center Street and North 22<sup>nd</sup> Street.

WISDOT has submitted the attached Project Agreement to be executed by the City of Milwaukee for the programming of the subject project with 100 percent SRTS funds.

We have prepared and recommend adoption of the attached resolution, which authorizes the Commissioner of Public Works to execute the Project Agreement, authorizes preliminary engineering, and authorizes the City Comptroller to create the proper accounts for the project.
