

This is to notify you that on January 19, 2010, the City's Licenses Committee voted to recommend to the City's Common Council that the Class "B" Tavern license for the premises at 2936 S. 13th St. ("The Brew House") be revoked based upon a police report, neighborhood testimony, testimony by a complainant and testimony by the district police captain.

On January 25, 2010, you were served with a true and correct copy of the findings of fact, conclusions of law and recommendations of the Licenses Committee with respect to the Class "B" Tavern license in which the Committee recommended that the license be revoked based upon a police report, neighborhood testimony, testimony by a complainant and testimony by the district police captain. You were further notified that the Milwaukee Common Council would consider the matter at its meeting of February 9, 2010 commencing at 9:00 a.m. in the Common Council Chambers on the third floor of City Hall, 200 East Wells Street, Milwaukee, Wisconsin. You were advised of your right to file written objections and to appear personally or by counsel to address the Common Council. At that date, time and place you did appear, and you did file written objections to the report of the Licenses Committee. You were represented by counsel.

Following consideration of the report of the Licenses Committee and your written objections, the Common Council adopted the recommendation of the Licenses Committee to revoke your Class "B" Tavern license based upon a police report, neighborhood testimony, testimony by a complainant and testimony by the district police captain.
