7:00AM TO 9:00AM MONDAY THROUGH FRIDAY
ON THE EAST SIDE OF SOUTH MUSKEGO AVENUE FROM
WEST GREENFIELD AVENUE TO A POINT 200 FEET SOUTH

Dear Alderman Witkowiak:

Due to high traffic volumes northbound on South Muskego Avenue during the morning rush hour, and the short green for traffic on South Muskego Avenue because of the complexity of the intersection at South Cesar Chavez Drive/West Greenfield Avenue, when vehicles are stopped or parked within 200 feet of the intersection on the east side of South Muskego Avenue, there are very long traffic backups northbound, resulting in vehicles having to wait up to three green lights to get through the traffic signal. Therefore, to prevent long traffic backups northbound during the morning rush hour, we recommend the installation of No Stopping Tow Away Zone on the east side of South Muskego Avenue from 7:00AM to 9:00AM Monday through Friday from South Cesar Chavez Drive to a point 200 feet south.

We will prepare the necessary legislation that will be heard at the next Public Safety Committee meeting, so you may support it to final passage.
