Dear Mr. Kraucunas:

This office is in receipt of your claim in the amount of \$124.99, relating to a solid waste fee charged place on you service bill for the property located at 2551 South 8th Street.

Our investigation reveals that Milwaukee Water Works records indicate that you contacted them on August 19, 2002 regarding the solid waste fee on your Municipal Services bill. They asked the Sanitation Division to follow up, however, no telephone number was provided. The request was closed on August 23, 2002. The solid waste fee is based on the number of dwelling units in a building, as certified by the City Assessor's office. Their records indicate that your property is listed as a two dwelling unit. Although you may think that it is a one-family, very often the physical changes that actually make it a one-family have not been done. It is their policy to require an interior inspection by them before changing a listing. Their records also indicate that they discussed this with you several times over the past two years and sent a letter and that you have refused to allow this. The City has acted appropriately in this matter and as such, the City would not be liable. Accordingly, we are denying your claim.

If you wish to appeal this decision, you may do so by sending a letter within 21 days of the receipt of this letter to the Milwaukee City Clerk, 200 East Wells Street, Room 205, Milwaukee, Wisconsin 53202, requesting a hearing.
