720.00 PURPOSE

720.10 NOTIFICATIONS

A. ~~SENSITIVE CRIMES~~ CRIMINAL INVESTIGATION BUREAU NOTIFICATION

Shift commanders shall ensure that ~~the Sensitive Crimes Division~~ a supervisor at the Criminal Investigation Bureau at extension [REDACTED] is aware of the critical missing.
