File # 021663 is a resolution relative to application, acceptance and funding of a "Save America's Treasure's" Grant through the United States Department of the Interior, National Parks Service, for improvements to City Hall.

# **Background**

- 1. This resolution authorizes the Department of Public Works (DPW) to apply for, accept and fund a "Save America's Treasure's" Grant through the United States Department of the Interior, National Parks Service, for improvements to City Hall.
- 2. This is a new grant.

# **Discussion**

- 1. As noted during the 2003 budget, as well as in a DPW report to the Common Council, City Hall requires extensive exterior and structural repairs to correct major deficiencies.
- 2. City Hall, as an important historic landmark, appears to be eligible for funding obtained from this federal grant.
- 3. The operation of this grant is September 2003 to September 2004.

### **Fiscal Impact**

- 1. The total amount of this grant is \$1,000,000 from the United States Department of the Interior, National Parks Service.
- 2. The city matching share of \$1,000,000 will be provided through the 2003 capital budget, which has authorized \$12.4 million for the City Hall restoration program.
- 3. The total cost projected for the City Hall restoration project is \$31.7 million over four years.
