The site is adjacent to the existing Fondy Farmers Market on Fond du Lac Avenue. The site is owned by the City. The site will feature a number of stormwater management features to help reduce local flooding and basement backups. This creation of this "stormwater park" is an addition to ECO's current North Avenue Greenscaping project taking place during 2016 and 2017.
