Instead, the Common Council voted, by a vote of sixteen (16) Ayes, zero (0) Nays, and one (1) Excused, to renew your Class "B" Tavern and Tavern Dance License without the imposition of any suspension period.


Dear Mr. Streff and Attorney Jacobson:
