To whom it may concern:

Please accept this letter in opposition to the request for a Public Entertainment License at the Quick Pick Food Mart, 2336 W Wisconsin Ave. Near West Side Partners has concerns about the current operation of the Quick Pick as detailed below and does not believe that the addition of amusement machines will better the current situation. Concerns include:

- **Loitering:** Loitering in the parking lot has been an ongoing issue for many years. Employees do little to actively discourage loitering at this site.
- **Litter and Trash:** The dumpsters that serve this business are often overflowing, leading to litter and debris scattered throughout the parking lot, and along 24th Street and Wisconsin Avenue. Daily clean-ups of the parking lot and adjacent sidewalks are needed.
- **Building and Overall Appearance:** In addition to issues related to trash and litter, NWSP is concerned about the overall appearance of the building. The building façade and parking area are in need of maintenance and upkeep.

has been in communication with the owner to discuss the concerns detailed above and, while objecting to the addition of the amusement machines, will continue to work with management to find sustainable solutions to the address these concerns.

This report is being written by PO CROWDER squad 3151/Dayshift, while in full duty uniform equipped with Axon worn body camera operating a marked squad car. On July 5th 2019, at 2:54pm PO HUMITZ and I were dispatched to a subject down located at 2336 W Wisconsin Av.

The caller stated that an unknown male was laying on the ground having convulsions and possibly overdosing. The caller spoke with MFD and stated the subject is none responsive.

The subject who was identified via law enforcement prior encounter as Jason D. TINSLEY (M/B, 12-1-85) was laying on the ground, seizing with foaming coming from his mouth. At this time I administered 4mg of Narcan to the right nostril of the subject. Moments later Milwaukee fire and rescue arrived on scene and I turned care over to them.

Lastly, at 3:01pm MFD Med #3 transported the subject to MT Sinai hospital. The subject was treated by MD. Bryan Klauk at 3:21pm. Several officers could smell the odor of intoxicants from the subject. Officers were unable to speak with the subject regarding but his condition could have been caused by intoxicants and heat combination.

Those wishing to provide oral testimony will be asked to do so by phone or internet and are asked to contact the staff assistant, Molly Kuether-Steele at (414) 286-2775 or [molly.kuether-steele@milwaukee.gov](mailto:molly.kuether-steele@milwaukee.gov) for necessary information. Please make such requests no later than one business day prior to the start of the meeting. You are not required to attend the hearing, but please see the information below if you would like to provide testimony. Once the Licenses Committee makes its recommendation, this recommendation is forwarded to the full Common Council for approval at its next regularly scheduled hearing.

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## Important details for those wishing to provide information for the Licenses Committee to consider when making its recommendation:

1. The license application is scheduled to be heard at the above time. Due to other hearings running longer than scheduled, you may have to wait some time to provide your testimony.
2. You must testify as to matters that you have personally experienced or seen. (You cannot provide testimony for your neighbor, parent or anyone else; this is considered hearsay and cannot be considered by the committee.)
3. No letters or petitions can be accepted by the committee (unless the person who wrote the letter or the persons who signed the petition are willing to testify).
4. Persons opposed to the license application are given the opportunity to testify first; supporters may testify after the opponents have finished.
5. When you are called to testify, you will be sworn in and asked to give your name, and address. (If your first and/or last names are uncommon please spell them.)
6. You may then provide testimony.
  - a. Include only information relating to the above license application.
  - b. Include only information you have personally witnessed or seen.
  - c. Provide concise and relevant information detailing how this business has affected or may affect the peaceful enjoyment of your neighborhood.
  - d. If by the time you have the opportunity to testify, the information you wish to share has already been provided to the committee, you may state that you agree with the previous testimony. Redundant or repetitive testimony will not assist the committee in making its recommendation.
7. After giving your testimony, the members of the Licenses Committee and the licensee may ask questions regarding the testimony you have given or other factors relating to the license application.
8. Business Competition is not a valid basis for denial or non-renewal of a license.

**Please Note: If you have submitted an objection to the above application your objection cannot be considered by the committee unless you personally testify at the hearing.**
