On Saturday, July 20, 2019, at 7:01 PM, P.O Dexter LEE and I were dispatched as squad 3241 to subject with weapon complaint located at 1608 N 35th St. This occurred in the City/County of Milwaukee, State of Wisconsin.

Upon arrival we met the caller later identified as SINGH, Kamal P (A/M 05/30/1981) SINGH stated that he notified police due to a disturbance that occurred inside the business (ABC Liquor). SINGH stated that the suspect later identified as GIBSON, Lenerdo T (B/M 01/10/1986) was punching the bullet proof windows, screaming inside the place of business causing him to fear for his safety. GIBSON actions were intentionally and without consent. SINGH also identified the suspect having a bamboo hat, white shirt with pink sleeves, and gray shorts. SINGH also stated that GIBSON had a brick in his hand.

During the initial interview SINGH notified us along with P.O Kayla BEIERLE and P.O Samuel RODEIGUEZ (Squad 3220) that GIBSON was located in the community park across the street. Upon of arriving at the community park across the street from the business, we were met by GIBSON who appeared to be angry. GIBSON stated that he was pissed off at Satan, claiming that he took too much. I asked GIBSON what had happen in the store, which GIBSON replied "I went up in there and said if yall aint got Jesus yall aint got nothing". I asked GIBSON if he had punched the glass window, which GIBSON replied "Yeah I punched the glass window but; I aint hit nobody". While conducting a search incident to arrest, P.O Kayla BEIERLE located a brown in color wooded pipe with charred ends commonly used to smoke marijuana. GIBSON was conveyed to District 3 and release. GIBSON received two citations for possession of drug paraphernalia and disorderly conduct.

On Tuesday, October 29, 2019 at 8:55PM P.O. Jeremie GAINER and I (Squad 3450) were dispatched to 1606 N. 35th St. (ABC Liquor Depot) for a threat call for service.

Upon arrival I spoke to the store owner Kamal Preet SINGH (w/m, 05-30-81) who stated earlier in the night at approximately 7:30PM an unknown suspect who he described as a B/M, 6'3", 120lbs, skinny build, wearing a gray knit hat, black leggings, black boots, a gray zip-up hoodie, and carrying a black purse/bag came into the store taking a gallon wine bottle values at \$10.99 without paying for it.

SINGH stated the male who was dressed as a female came back into the store at approximately 8:40PM handing him \$10 and acting like he did not steal anything earlier. SINGH stated he told the subject that he was keeping the money as payment for the bottle earlier that was taken. SINGH stated the subject became upset and had kids with him. SINGH stated he observed the subject walk around the store and then tried to walk out of the store. SINGH stated another employee; Donald E. GARRETT (b/m, 8-26-76) attempted to close the door to lock the subject in so they could call the police regarding the earlier theft. GARRETT stated the subject pulled a silver handled box cutter out of her bag stating "get away from me or I'll cut you with this box cutter". GARRETT stated this caused him to fear for his safety and so he stepped out of the way not wanting to get cut. SINGH stated as the subject left the store he said "we gonna be waiting for you guys outside". SINGH stated he took this as a threat and that the subject was going to try and do something to him as he was walking to his car. SINGH stated the subject entered a blue Lincoln Navigator bearing WI Plate #AFD-7782.

SINGH stated the subject is always in the store because he believes the subject lives in the area somewhere on N. 34th St. however he does not know the subject's name.

The incident was captured on video however you can not actually see a knife in the video. Follow-up will need to be conducted in order to recover the video and attempt to ID the suspect further since SINGH stated he needed to leave for the night.

On Friday, November 22nd, 2019, squad 3430, P.O. Ryan DOMBECK and I, were dispatched to a threat complaint located at 1606 N. 35th St. in the City and County of Milwaukee. Upon arrival I spoke with the caller, Kamal P. SINGH (w/m, 05/30/1981) who stated that "Tasha", later identified as Latasha L. DARNELL (b/f, 07/10/1974), stated that she would shoot him and that she would return later. SINGH stated that DARNELL was driving a green jeep with a license plate of AFD-7631. SINGH stated that the statements DARNELL made were threatening and caused him to fear for his safety. DARNELL returned to the location while officers were on scene. A check through DOT revealed the reverse listed Milwaukee Co. Sheriff's warrant for DARNELL. DARNELL was taken into custody and conveyed to the Milwaukee Police Department District Three station for processing. DARNELL was also issued a citation for Disorderly Conduct.

This report is written by Police Officer Quinton Holeman assigned to District 3, Modified Early.

On April 9th, 2020 at approximately 11:27 A.M. Police Officer Nicholas Ulatowski and I in full Milwaukee Police Uniform while wearing fixed body worn cameras was dispatched to a entry complaint located at 1606 N 35th St. This is located in the city and county of Milwaukee, WI.

Upon arrival, I was greeted by the owner of the ABC Liquor store SINGH, Kamal (M/B 05/30/1981) who stated on April 5, 2020 at approximately 11:07 P.M. a Unknown black male wearing orange pants, grey hoodie, black shoes, with a full beard intentionally and without consent broken into the liquor store and stole \$2,750 dollars worth of merchandise. This act was done intentionally and without consent.

SINGH stated he observed the hole in the ceiling which is located on the north side of the store on Monday April 6, 2020 at approximately 12:00 P.M. when he came to work. SINGH stated when he observed the hole he did not observe anything to be missing and all of his merchandise was accounted for. Singh stated he did not see anyone on his surveillance system. On April 8, 2020 he called the police regarding a different incident for a different individual and when he went to gather video evidence for the police officer for an incident that occurred outside of his store, he observed the unknown black male breaking into his store on camera. SINGH stated he waited to make the report today when he saw the unknown black male on his camera.

SINGH stated the unknown black male took the following from behind the register:

18 Cartons of Newport 100's cigarettes valued at \$1700.

14 Pints of Hennessy and 20 half pints of Hennessy valued at \$500 dollars.

Gold coins valued at \$500.

SINGH stated this was done intentionally and without consent.

The video of the incident shows the unknown black male enter the business at approximately 11:07 P.M. from the hole in the ceiling on the north side of the building. Let it be known the glass behind the counter is in a L shape. The unknown black male turns west and then turns south towards the cigarettes. The video captures the unknown black male put 18 cartons of cigarettes into a light colored duffel bag which were located on the south wall. Then Unknown black male then turns to the west wall behind the counter and puts 14 pints of Hennessy and 20 1/2 pints of Hennessy in the light colored duffel bag. After the Unknown black male put the Hennessy in the light colored duffel bag, he then turned back south where he found a plastic see through container which contained 500 gold coins. The video observed the unknown black male take the gold coins and put them in the light colored duffel bag.

SINGH stated he entered through the south side window on the second floor of the building. SINGH stated he pried open the vent to gain access to the building. SINGH stated the window he gained access

to was a vacant apartment above the liquor store. SINGH stated he then went through the apartment and exited out the front door and went half way down the stairs where the unknown subject then began to make a hole in the dry wall to gain access to the store. SINGH stated he believes the unknown subject used a hammer to get through the drywall. After he created a hole through the drywall, the unknown subject then began to make a hole through the ceiling tile in order to gain access to the store. SINGH stated after he made a hole through the ceiling tile, he took the alcohol that is located on the top shelf and put the alcohol on the stairwell of the apartment. SINGH stated the unknown black male was seen entering and leaving from the same hole in the ceiling.

SINGH stated he has American Family Insurance

P.O. Ulatowski processed the scene.

I gave SINGH a PV-17 and a community contact card.

Those wishing to provide oral testimony will be asked to do so by phone or internet and are asked to contact the staff assistant, Molly Kuether-Steele at (414) 286-2775 or molly.kuether-steele@milwaukee.gov for necessary information. Please make such requests no later than one business day prior to the start of the meeting. You are not required to attend the hearing, but please see the information below if you would like to provide testimony. Once the Licenses Committee makes its recommendation, this recommendation is forwarded to the full Common Council for approval at its next regularly scheduled hearing.

Important details for those wishing to provide information for the Licenses Committee to consider when making its recommendation:

- 1. The license application is scheduled to be heard at the above time. Due to other hearings running longer than scheduled, you may have to wait some time to provide your testimony.
- 2. You must testify as to matters that you have personally experienced or seen. (You cannot provide testimony for your neighbor, parent or anyone else; this is considered hearsay and cannot be considered by the committee.)
- 3. No letters or petitions can be accepted by the committee (unless the person who wrote the letter or the persons who signed the petition are willing to testify).
- 4. Persons opposed to the license application are given the opportunity to testify first; supporters may testify after the opponents have finished.
- 5. When you are called to testify, you will be sworn in and asked to give your name, and address. (If your first and/or last names are uncommon please spell them.)

- 6. You may then provide testimony.
- a. Include only information relating to the above license application.
- b. Include only information you have personally witnessed or seen.
- c. Provide concise and relevant information detailing how this business has affected or may affect the peaceful enjoyment of your neighborhood.
- d. If by the time you have the opportunity to testify, the information you wish to share has already been provided to the committee, you may state that you agree with the previous testimony. Redundant or repetitive testimony will not assist the committee in making its recommendation.
- 7. After giving your testimony, the members of the Licenses Committee and the licensee may ask questions regarding the testimony you have given or other factors relating to the license application.
- 8. Business Competition is not a valid basis for denial or non-renewal of a license.

Please Note: If you have submitted an objection to the above application your objection cannot be considered by the committee unless you personally testify at the hearing.
