The Milwaukee Police Department's investigation regarding this application revealed the following:

- 1. On 09/09/23 at 12:05pm, Milwaukee Police were dispatched to 3565 N Teutonia Av, for an entry complaint. Officers spoke with the agent who stated that a subject got in to the business after hours and took money from the business drawer. Officers reviewed the video of the incident. The video showed the suspect entering the business by breaking a window and taking property from the drawer of the business. Officers recovered some evidence from the scene and filed the incident as a burglary.
- 2. On 09/11/23 at 4:36am, Milwaukee Police were dispatched to 3565 N Teutonia Av, for an entry complaint. Officers spoke with the agent who stated that a subject got into the business after hours by breaking a window and removed property. Officers reviewed video which showed the suspect's description and the incident in it's entirely. The suspect is believed to be the same suspect wanted for burglary which occurred to the business, a few days prior.

On Saturday, September 9th, 2023, at 12:05pm we were dispatched to an entry complaint at the address of 3565 N Teutonia Ave. Upon arrival I spoke with the owner of the location, which is Jack's Beverage Center. The owner was identified as Sukhjinder SINGH (w/m 1-1-80). SINGH stated that on today's date he received a notification from his security company that an alarm had activated at the above location. SINGH stated that he then arrived at the location at approximately 10:00am and observed that a window on the east side of the building had been broken and was boarded up. SINGH stated that he was then able to view video surveillance inside the location which showed an unknown male behind the counter of the location at 4:32am. This male was observed forcing open the cash register and taking an unknown amount of US currency from the cash drawer and then leaving the scene.

I was able to view this video footage which shows an unknown black male, approximately 40 years of age, with a short haircut, behind the counter of the location. I was able to observe that this male was wearing a jacket which had a gray top, white middle, and black bottom, along with blue jeans and white sandals. This male is observed behind the counter at 4:32pm during which he is observed forcefully opening the cash drawer and removing US currency from the drawer. The male then leaves out of view. The point of entry, which again is on the east side of the building is not on video surveillance, and I observed the point of entry was secured.

SINGH stated that nothing else was obtained during this incident and was unable to provide any exact amount of currency that was obtained. SINGH stated that he does have insurance on the property but was unable to provide the name of the carrier.

I was able to locate an additional call for service that was placed at 5:22pm by Metro Security indicating that they had received an alarm from the above location. This call for service was assigned CAD 23-252-0286. I did not locate any other additional calls for service that were placed by any citizens regarding this incident.

Squad 5165, PO Brian MATTE and PO Matthew WAGNER then arrived on scene and took photographs of the scene. A small amount of blood was then located directly inside the window that was broken as well as on the shelving directly adjacent to the cash register. These blood samples were then collected by PO Brian MATTE and later inventoried at District Five. See PO MATTE's supplemental reporting regarding the photographs and DNA evidence collection. PO WAGNER was also able to retrieve the video surveillance from the location and this video evidence was later uploaded to evidence.com.

Acting Lt. Justin SEBESTYEN was notified of the circumstances of this incident.

I then conducted a canvass of the surround area with the following results: The following addresses are vacant properties that are in view of the point of entry. 3546 N Teutonia Ave, 3548 N Teutonia Ave, and the building directly to the north, which I did not observe a posted address on is also vacant at this time.

On Monday, September 11th 2023 at 4:36 AM, squad 5340 (PO GREGORY and I) was dispatched to Jack's Liquor Center, located at 3565 N Teutonia Ave regarding an Entry complaint. Upon arrival I spoke with

the manager/owner, identified as - SukhJinder SINGH (W/M, 01-01-80) who stated that he received a call from ADT regarding an entry alarm that activated at 3:30 AM. SINGH arrived to his business and observed that a window had been broken on the east side of the building by a brick. The window is about (8-10) feet above the sidewalk and is about $4' \times 4'$.

Metro Security was on scene when we arrived but left after we cleared the business and were not able to get their information. In the CAD it states that REED called (PH# 414-213-7615).

I was able to view video footage which shows the suspect, who is observed to be a black male, approximately 600 tall, thin bulld, short haircut, white T-shirt, dark pants and white slides. Video surveillance only captures suspect inside of the location and not the point of entry. The camera does not capture the suspect enter the business but does show him at the register.

The cameras capture the suspect on Monday, September 11th, 2023, at 2:20 AM to 2:21 AM when the cameras detected motion inside the business.

PO GREGORY took multiple digital photographs at 7:00 AM

Stolen:

(10) packs of cigarettes (possibly Newport) - \$120.00

US Currency (coins) - \$160.00

Damage to window - \$500.00

It's believed that the suspect then exited the same way he entered.

This incident might be related to an Entry, which occurred on 09-08-23 (IR 23-252-0061). The suspect matches the same description and MO.

I notified acting Lieutenant (Sergeant KIRK), he called CIB and spoke with Lt. REAVES at 6:01 AM, who stated that they would not be responding and that it was ours to handle.



Those wishing to provide oral testimony via internet are asked to contact the staff assistant, Yadira Melendez at (414) 286-2775 or stasst5@milwaukee.gov for necessary information. Please make such requests no later than one business day prior to the start of the meeting. You are not required to attend the hearing, but please see the information below if you would like to provide testimony. Once the Licenses Committee makes its recommendation, this recommendation is forwarded to the full Common Council for approval at its next regularly scheduled hearing.

Important details for those wishing to provide information for the Licenses Committee to consider when making its recommendation:

- 1. The license application is scheduled to be heard at the above time. Due to other hearings running longer than scheduled, you may have to wait some time to provide your testimony.
- 2. You must appear in person and testify as to matters that you have personally experienced or seen. (You cannot provide testimony for your neighbor, parent or anyone else; this is considered hearsay and cannot be considered by the committee.)
- 3. No letters or petitions can be accepted by the committee (unless the person who wrote the letter or the persons who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify).
- 4. Persons opposed to the license application are given the opportunity to testify first; supporters may testify after the opponents have finished.
- 5. When you are called to testify, you will be sworn in and asked to give your name, and address. (If your first and/or last names are uncommon please spell them.)

- 6. You may then provide testimony.
- a. Include only information relating to the above license application.
- b. Include only information you have personally witnessed or seen.
- c. Provide concise and relevant information detailing how this business has affected or may affect the peaceful enjoyment of your neighborhood.
- d. If by the time you have the opportunity to testify, the information you wish to share has already been provided to the committee, you may state that you agree with the previous testimony. Redundant or repetitive testimony will not assist the committee in making its recommendation.
- 7. After giving your testimony, the members of the Licenses Committee and the licensee may ask questions regarding the testimony you have given or other factors relating to the license application.
- 8. Business Competition is not a valid basis for denial or non-renewal of a license.

Please Note: If you have submitted an objection to the above application your objection cannot be considered by the committee unless you personally testify at the hearing.
