File # 041719 is a resolution amending Common Council File # 041390 relative to application, acceptance and funding of a Milwaukee Metropolitan Drug Enforcement Grant.

# **Background**

- 1. This resolution amends Common Council File # 041390 that authorized the Milwaukee Police Department (MPD) to apply for, accept and fund a Milwaukee Metropolitan Drug Enforcement project from the U.S. Department of Justice, Bureau of Justice Assistance through the Wisconsin Office of Justice Assistance.
- 2. This grant amendment is due to the receipt of additional funding.

## **Discussion**

- 1. The purpose of the Milwaukee Metropolitan Drug Enforcement project is to reduce the volume of controlled substances in the Milwaukee area through the prevention and suppression of illegal drug activity.
- 2. This grant funds one existing Police Officer position and one new Lieutenant of Detectives position with a portion of salary and fringe benefits.
- 3. The extra grant funding will be used for Confidential Funds.
- 4. This grant encompasses the period of January 1, 2005 through December 31, 2005.

## **Fiscal Effect**

- 1. The total increase of this grant is \$57,236 with \$40,000 provided by the grantor and \$17,236 provided by the city.
- 2. The city portion of the grant includes the MPD share of salary and fringe benefits as well as indirect costs (\$37,875) associated with grant administration.
