The work was found to be consistent with preservation guidelines. The following conditions apply to this certificate of appropriateness:
The new sunroom will be constructed of aluminum and glass and will measure 9'8" x 19'9" with a 2 in 12 pitched roof. The existing railing will be removed in order to construct the sunroom.

All work must be done in a craftsman-like manner, and must be completed within one year of the date this certificate was issued. Staff must approve any changes or additions to this certificate before work begins. Work that is not completed in accordance with this certificate may be subject to correction orders or citations.
