WHEREAS, *Sergeant Tracey Smith was a 23-year veteran of the Wisconsin Department of Corrections, starting her career with the DOC in March 1996 as a youth counselor at Ethan Allen School for Boys in Delafield, and later transferring to the Milwaukee Secure Detention Facility (MSDF) when it opened in August 2001, and while at MSDF she held many positions including her most recent assignment as the property sergeant; and*

WHEREAS, *Tracey was baptized at an early age at Calvary Baptist Church, and being an avid reader, she enjoyed reading the Bible and kept Post-It notes on her bedroom dresser mirrors and walls with hand-written biblical scriptures, and her love for reading didn't stop at just the Bible, it involved all kinds of books about the Bible including many books by Christian authors; and*

WHEREAS, *Tracey A. Smith leaves to cherish her memory her sons, Corey Jr. and Caleb, parents Ollie and Joanne Luckett, her sister Sherri, nephew Nathan, her lifetime partner Marcus Jemison and a host of other loving relatives and friends; now, therefore, be it*
